A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, RANKING ARCHITECTURAL/ENGINEERING FIRMS AND AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH THE HIGHEST RANKED FIRM TO PROVIDE ARCHITECTURAL/ENGINEERING PROGRAMMING AND GENERAL CONSULTING SERVICES FOR THE POLICE HEADQUARTERS PROJECT.

This resolution requests the City Commission rank the firms providing Architectural/Engineering services for the City's new Police Headquarters project and to enter into a Professional Services agreement with the approved firm. The City's evaluation committee reviewed Statement of Qualifications, held Oral Interviews, and ranked the two top firms as follows:

1. McClaren Wilson & Lawrie, Inc.
2. Netta Architects

Funding for the project was provided by amending the Fiscal Year 2019 Capital Improvement Plan via Resolution, R-2019-147 approved by City Commission on June 5, 2019 to include all GOB projects.

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
