SUBJECT:	Recommendation to Approve the Issuance of a Purcha USA, LLC for the emergency provision and delivery of to the Southern Regional Wastewater Treatment Plant production facility in an amount up to \$123,894.72. The used is Emergency.	Liquid Oxygen (LOX) (SRWWTP) cryogenic

ISSUE:

On August 28, 2023, the SRWWTP cryogenic facility experienced unanticipated, and unexplained, pressure and purity issues during the oxygen (O2) production process. SRWWTP staff responded by securing specialized cryogenics repair services from Ranch Cryogenics, Inc., (Ranch). A functioning cryogenics plant is necessary for proper wastewater treatment. Lack of consistent oxygen generation would also make the SRWWTP noncompliant with their operating permit and jeopardize public health and safety.

The system evaluation by Ranch required the temporary cessation of oxygen production. The SRWWTP, therefore arranged for the emergency delivery of Liquid Oxygen (LOX) from AIRGAS USA, LLC (Airgas) for use while the cryogenic plant was under diagnostic investigation and repair.

LOX expenditures for the diagnostic and repair cessation totaled \$123,894.72 above the previously authorized CM Memo PU-24-09 in an amount of \$500,000.00.

The DPU requests approval for the issuance of a purchase order to AIRGAS USA, LLC for the previously procured emergency LOX, in a total amount of up to \$123,894.72.

AUTHORITY:

§ 38.41 COMPETITIVE SOLICITATIONS REQUIRED; EXCEPTIONS (C)(1) Emergency purchases:

In urgent cases of compelling emergency that require the immediate purchase of goods, supplies, materials, equipment or services, the CPO is authorized to secure, when possible, emergency goods, supplies, materials, equipment, or services by open market procedure. All such emergency purchases must receive prior administrative approval except for the most urgent situations presenting a clear and present substantial threat to life or property where immediate action is required.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Director of Public Utilities recommends authorization of the issuance of a Purchase Order to AIRGAS USA, LLC., for the emergency supply of Liquid Oxygen (LOX) to the Southern Regional Wastewater Treatment Plant (SRWWTP) cryogenic plant in an amount up to \$123,894.72.
