A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, AWARDED INVITATION FOR BID NO. IFB-361-26-JJ FOR LAKES NEIGHBORHOOD EXFILTRATION PHASE I TO MAN-CON, INC.; APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH MAN-CON, INC., FOR CONSTRUCTION SERVICES RELATED TO HOLLYWOOD LAKES NEIGHBORHOOD EXFILTRATION – PHASE I PROJECT IN AN AMOUNT UP TO \$4,539,045.00.

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Utilities (“Department”) is preparing to implement a utility improvement project, including a new stormwater drainage system; and

WHEREAS, the Department desires to engage qualified contractors to provide construction services for the planned drainage improvement projects; and

WHEREAS, the Department applied for and was awarded the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (“FDEP”) Resiliency Grant in the amount of \$3,255,000.00 for the Lakes Neighborhood Exfiltration – Phase 1 Project, with a required grant match of \$3,255,000.00; and

WHEREAS, on November 20, 2025, Invitation for Bid No. IFB-361-26-JJ for Lake Neighborhood Exfiltration Phase I, including 38-unit prices and 5 allowances (“Project”), was electronically advertised on OpenGov in accordance with Section 38.43(A) of the Procurement Code; and

WHEREAS, on February 12, 2026, bid proposals were received in response to the aforementioned invitation and opened at 3:00 pm with the following results:

WHEREAS, the Department and Office of Procurement and Performance Management staff thoroughly evaluated the bids received for responsiveness and responsibility in accordance with Section 38.43(F) of the City’s Procurement Code, and

Man-Con, Inc. (“Man-Con”) was determined to be the lowest responsive and responsible bidder; and

WHEREAS, on February 24, 2026, a Notice of Intent to Award was posted on the City’s website and on OpenGov, and resulted in no bid protests; and

WHEREAS, the Department Director and the Director of Procurement and Performance Management recommend that the City Commission award Invitation for Bid No. IFB-361-26-JJ to Man-Con and approve and authorize the appropriate City officials to execute a contract with Man-Con, Inc. in an amount up to \$4,539,045.00 for construction services related to the Hollywood Lakes Neighborhood Exfiltration – Phase I; and

WHEREAS, the estimated time to substantially complete the Project will be 445 days from the Notice to Proceed date; and

WHEREAS, funding for this project was included in the amended FY 2026 Capital Improvement Plan, and is available in account numbers 443.419901.53800.563010.001783.000.000 and 443.409802.53800.563010.001783.000.000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the foregoing “WHEREAS” clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are incorporated in this Resolution.

Section 2: That it awards the Invitation for Bid No. IFB-361-26-JJ to the lowest responsive, responsible bidder, Man-Con, Inc.

Section 3: That it approves and authorizes the execution, by the appropriate City officials, of a contract with Man-Con, Inc. in an amount up to \$4,539,045.00, for construction services related to the Hollywood Lakes Neighborhood Exfiltration – Phase I, together with such non-material changes as may be subsequently agreed to by the City Manager and approved as to form and legal sufficiency by the City Attorney.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
