3) Education (Art & Culture Center/Hollywood, Arts School, ArtsPark at Young Circle, Hollywood Central Performing Arts Center).

- Summer Arts Camp (June-August 2017): Up to 18 sessions, 2-4 weeks long, in the visual/performing arts for ages 4-18; includes two stage performances by Broadway Actors campers ages 8-17; 10 gallery and theater presentations by Young Artists, Young Actors campers (ages 6-12); six gallery and theater presentations by Littlest Artists, Little Actors (ages 4-6).
- Teen Arts Ambassadors (Sept. 2016 to Aug. 2017): Career and academic development program for high-school students
- Distance Learning Arts Studio (Oct. 2016 to May 2017): Up to 15 instructional sessions delivered via a 2-way teleconferencing network to Broward public schools.
- Student Gallery Exhibitions: Up to 8 shows featuring K-12 schools, non-profit organizations, and students enrolled in Center classes.
- ARTastic Collaborations (Oct. 2016 to Feb. 2017): Visual and performing arts classes for ages 6-10.
- Stage Kids (Oct. 2016 through March 2017): Performing arts classes for ages 8-14.
- Private voice, piano, flute and guitar lessons, ongoing.
- Outreach activities to schools and educational organizations.

4) Theatre: Management of events at the Hollywood Central Performing Arts Center, includes Center programming, rentals to outside organizations, and events presented by Broward County Public Schools and the City of Hollywood.
