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A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE A FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE INTERLOCAL AND LEASE AGREEMENT WITH THE SCHOOL BOARD OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, FOR THE DRIFTWOOD ELEMENTARY AND DRIFTWOOD MIDDLE SCHOOLS RECREATIONAL AREA AND SWIMMING POOL.

WHEREAS, the School Board or Broward County ("SBBC") and the City, because of the heavy demand for recreational activities existing in the City as a result of the increase of the population of school children, entered into an Interlocal Agreement ("Agreement") dated October 15, 2002 to meet community needs; and

WHEREAS, the City and SBBC continue to support and endorse the concept of providing a multipurpose recreational facility that meets community needs and provides linkage between the school system, the City, and numerous civic and community groups; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of the Agreement, SBBC agreed to enter into a long-term lease for the Driftwood Community Center and appurtenances for a period of 40 years; and

WHEREAS, the City and SBBC believe that such established arrangement will continue to be of mutual benefit to all parties and will continue filling a great need in that area of the community, and that cooperation between the parties produces great benefits to the residents of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City and SBBC wish to amend the Agreement pursuant to Section 163.01, Florida Statutes, for the purpose of updating articles for the use and operation of the Driftwood Elementary/Middle Schools recreational area and swimming pool based on the provisions contained in the Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA:

<u>Section 1</u>: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are incorporated in this Resolution.
