

RESOLUTION NO. R-CRA-2019-

A RESOLUTION OF THE HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY, REPEALING RESOLUTION R-CRA-2012-25 ESTABLISHING A MURAL REVIEW COMMITTEE.

WHEREAS, on May 2, 2012, the Hollywood, Florida Community Redevelopment Agency (“CRA”) Board, through R-CRA-2012-25, established a mural review committee for murals that would be located in the Music District of the Downtown District of the CRA; and

WHEREAS, on March 20, 2019, the City Commission passed and adopted Ordinance No. O-2019-03, which repealed Section 8.4 of the Zoning and Land Development regulations that set forth the review process for murals located in the CRA Mural Program Area; and

WHEREAS, the CRA wishes to repeal Resolution R-CRA-2012-25 and create a grant program that will allow for murals in the Downtown and Beach Districts.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY:

Section 1: That the foregoing “WHEREAS” clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are incorporated in this Resolution.

Section 2: That it repeals Resolution R-CRA-2012-25.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
