A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE THE ATTACHED HIGHWAY MAINTENANCE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD AND THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF CONCRETE **SIDEWALKS** AND BIKE LANES IN HOLLYWOOD GARDENS WEST, (JOHNSON STREET TO THE NORTH, HOLLYWOOD BOULEVARD TO THE SOUTH, 56TH AVENUE TO THE EAST AND SR7 TO THE DEPARTMENT WEST). ΒY THE FLORIDA TRANSPORTATION THROUGH BROWARD COUNTY MPO COMPLETE STREETS FUNDING (STATE FM NO. 434679-1-52-01).

WHEREAS, the roads within the Hollywood Gardens West neighborhood are part of the City's Roadway System; and

WHEREAS, the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization (Broward MPO) has committed funding from Federal and State sources to promote Mobility Projects programs, including sidewalk and bike lane networks which are part of the Complete Streets Initiative; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission adopted Resolution R-2016-012 on January 20, 2016 in support of the Florida Department of Transportation's Delivery of Sidewalk and Bicycle Lane Improvements, specifically Project No. 434679-52-01, the Hollywood Gardens West Sidewalk and Bike Path Project; and

WHEREAS, the Broward MPO allocated funding for City of Hollywood improvements with a value of approximately \$4,500,000.00 (\$4.53 million/\$4,532,897.00) within their FY 2017-2021 Transportation Improvement Program for a Sidewalk and Bike Lane project within the Hollywood Gardens West neighborhood and portions of Taft Street; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), in coordination with the City of Hollywood, and the Broward MPO have developed Construction Documents for the project, held public meetings, and initiated permitting and constructability reviews; and

WHEREAS, FDOT will contract for and construct the improvements including construction of missing sidewalk segments within Hollywood Gardens West

and along Taft Street from N. 20th Avenue to N. 14th Avenue, installation of bike lanes on existing pavement along Glenn and Columbus Parkways, installation of nineteen drainage inlets with drain fields, re-grading as needed to create bio swales and pedestrian lighting improvements at the intersection of SR7 and Johnson Street and US1 and Taft Street, signage and pavement markings; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hollywood has jurisdiction and maintains the roadway pavement within the right of way of Hollywood Gardens West and Taft Street and will continue to maintain the newly constructed improvements in accordance with Federal and State standards; and

WHEREAS, FDOT requires that this understanding between the City and FDOT be formalized through the execution of the attached Highway Maintenance Memorandum of Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA:

<u>Section 1</u>: That it hereby approves and authorizes the execution, by the appropriate City Officials, of the attached Highway Maintenance Memorandum of Agreement, together with such non-material changes as may be acceptable to the City Manager and approved as to form and legality by the City Attorney.

<u>Section 2:</u> That this resolution shall be in full force and effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.
