




#### **Scope of Work**

The pathway project consists of demolition and widening of the pathways. They will be clearing and grubbing along the new pathway border.

There will be erosion control in the areas where the pathway is closer to the canal.

Existing bollards along the path will be removed and replaced. New removable bollards will be put in at the Johnson Street pathway entrance and at the bridge connecting Lyons Park. New fence gate access at south end and the Knights of Columbus fence line.

At the start of the pathway at Johnson Street, new lighting fixtures will be installed up to the Knights of Columbus fence line.








**Project Location** 

Stan Goldman is a roughly 12.5 acre park located at 800 Knights Road. The park is bordered by Johnson Street on the north, Hollywood Boulevard on the South, C-10 canal on the west, and the Tri-rail on the east. There is a foot bridge on the southwest corner of the park connecting to Lions Park.

The park consists of Pickleball courts, a skate park, a playground, Hollywood Dog Park, two restrooms, a walking path, and a small fishing area.








#### **MAP LEGEND**

Lighting Location
















## Phasing Plan








Match-line between North and South.
