Explanation:

On November 6, 1974, the City Commission passed and adopted Resolution No. R-74-189 which authorized the execution of a 40 year lease agreement with the School Board of Broward County ("SBBC") for the purpose of allowing the City to improve and utilize land Site 156 (commonly known as Washington Park) which is owned by SBBC.

This lease agreement will expire on September 19, 2014, and the parties desire to enter into a new agreement for another 40 year term to continue to utilize, maintain, and improve Washington Park. The rental cost for the city will be one dollar (\$1.00) per year each yearly anniversary of this agreement. It is the responsibility of the City to maintain and keep the Leased Premises clean, sanitary, free from debris, and mowed to prevent unsightly accumulation of weeds and other vegetation. Funding will be requested in each of the subsequent applicable fiscal years.
