In 2004, the Miami-Dade County Water and Sewer Department (MDWASD) entered into a Consent Decree with the United States Environmental Protection Agency which mandated that the County's South District Wastewater Treatment Plant be upgraded to incorporate a 285 million gallon per day (mgd) capacity reclaimed water filtration system. In addition, the Decree mandated that the facility meet Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) High Level Disinfection (HLD) reclaimed water standards, as well as water quality equivalent to primary drinking water standards. This facility will be the largest in Florida to treat wastewater to these stringent standards, and the treated wastewater will be reclaimed for use as electrical cogeneration cooling water and for irrigation of green space at Zoo Miami (previously known as Miami-Dade Metro Zoo). Due to the aggressive completion schedule mandated in the Decree, planning, pilot testing, design, and construction were fast-tracked.

In January 2010, P&K was awarded the contract for construction of the Effluent Pump Station No. 2. Improvements included under the project comprise the following components:

- Two 15,000 gallon steel surge tank(s)
- A 720,000 gallon cast-in-place concrete effluent wetwell for the effluent pumps
- Six (6) 20.5 mgd capacity, 900 horsepower stainless steel vertical turbine effluent pumps, each equipped with a variable frequency drive (VFD).
- A 12,000 square foot, multi-level pump building to house the pumps, electrical gear, controls, and operating and maintenance equipment. Included all foundation, structural, architectural, plumbing, and HVAC work.
- An electrical room to house the electrical switchgear, VFDs, and instrumentation and controls

- Extensive yard electrical demolition and new construction
- Approximately 550 linear feet of 90-inch, 72-inch, 60-inch, and 42-inch prestressed concrete cylinder pipe (PCCP) and other extensive yard piping, including two 72"x60" cut-in connections and one 72"x24" hot tap connection.

During construction of the three-story building, Poole & Kent installed a cofferdam with concrete tremie seal. Poole & Kent placed large volumes of concrete including a 3,500 yard tremie placement, 1,500 yard foundation slab, and over 2,000 yards of concrete for vertical walls, beams, columns, slabs, and floor along with precast joists. In addition, the project required secondary concrete placement of Vortex Pier Fillets & Baffle Walls located in the Pump Station Wet Well.

Being that the three-story building had to be completely dried within a 12-month time period including masonry, doors, louvers, windows, pre-cast joist, roof and exterior stucco, Poole & Kent management directed its subcontractor to construct all columns and beams and start construction of the roof prior to starting the masonry work. This innovative idea allowed multiple contractors to work concurrently and expedite the construction schedule.

P&K was responsible for scheduling, coordination, procurement, and execution of all aspects of construction of the facilities and process equipment. Due to the high volume of construction work being conducted on the site by other contractors outside of the effluent pump station project (14 other construction contracts were under way concurrently), successful completion of the project required extremely close coordination and cooperation with the Owner, Engineer, and other construction contractors.

South District Wastewater **TREATMENT PLANT** HLD UPGRADE TO 285-MGD FILTER SYSTEM, CONTRACT S-805

In June 2008, Poole & Kent Company of Florida (P&K) was awarded the contract for construction of the HLD Filter System Upgrade, one of the largest deep bed sand filter systems in the United States, consisting of 30 cells measuring 15.25 feet by 88 feet with six feet of sand filter media and with space for future expansion up to 48 cells.

Improvements included under the project include the following components:

- Three flocculation trains built within a single cast-in-place concrete tank, each equipped with flash mixing followed by slow mixing to enhance solids removal by the downstream filter system.
- Thirty deep-bed sand, mono-media wastewater filters, including cast-in-place concrete basins, a filter underdrain system, filter media, washwater troughs, filter gallery piping, and control instrumentation.
 - The filter underdrain piping consists of 30 36" diameter x 95' long pipe runs which each has 66 4" outlets. Each outlet further divides into 2 branches which are cast into the foundation slab concrete and

must be installed within a tolerance of 1/16". Poole & Kent designed and constructed a template which helped to meet the required tolerance and has been adopted by the manufacturer as the recommended method of installation.

- Poole & Kent constructed two cofferdams on the north and south sides of the flocculation tank to transfer 285 mgd of wastewater to each of the 30 deep bed sand filters.
- The deep bed filters contain 18,000 tons of gravel and filter media, 0 which must be backwashed during installation. The specified construction sequence required that the permanent pumping

equipment be used to perform this backwashing. The S-805 project is dependent upon another project to supply electrical power for the pumping equipment. Poole & Kent performed the gravel and media installation early, without the benefit of the permanent pumping equipment, by backwashing with a temporary pumping system. This also resulted in a substantial improvement in the construction schedule.

- This contract included 44,000 cubic yards of cast-in-place concrete. The specified schedule and sequence allocated 40 months for construction of this portion of the work. Poole & Kent completed this portion of the work to the complete satisfaction of the Owner and the Engineer in 24 months without any deficiencies by utilizing two structural subcontractors to perform the concrete work.
- The project included both hydraulic structures (tanks) and buildings which house various types of mechanical and electrical plant equipment. The tanks were constructed by one of the structural subcontractors and the buildings by the other. This innovative idea by Poole & Kent resulted in expedited completion of both the tank and building structures. At the height of concrete construction at least 1,000 cubic yards of concrete were being placed every week.

- A filter backwash system consisting of three 275,000-gallon cast-in-place concrete backwash water supply tanks, eight horizontal split case, 200 horsepower (Hp), 8,000 gallons per minute (gpm), constant speed backwash pumps, backwash piping, and associated electrical, instrumentation, and controls.
- An air-scour system for the filter backwash system consisting of seven 500 Hp, 12,000 cubic feet per minute (cfm) positive displacement air blowers, air piping, filters, silencers, and instrumentation and controls.
- A backwash waste handling system consisting of three 500,000-gallon cast-in-place concrete waste washwater tanks and eight horizontal split case, 200 Hp, 8,000 gpm washwater pumps equipped with variable frequency drives, wastewater piping, and associated electrical, instrumentation, and controls.
- A 22,200 square foot (sf) North Filter Building to house air blowers and backwash supply and waste pumps for the North Filters, and a 22,200 sf South Filter Building to house the air blowers and backwash pumps for the South Filters, both buildings including architectural, structural, electrical, HVAC, and plumbing systems.
- A polymer filter aid storage, preparation, and feed system housed in a 4,200 sf Polymer Building.
- All major utilities including 6-24" water mains, waste lines, flush water lines, fire hydrants, chlorine piping, potable water, pluming fixtures in filter building, storm water drainage, manholes, and catch basins.
- All associated sitework, yard piping, plumbing, electrical, instrumentation, and controls improvements.

In addition, shortly after the Contract was awarded, MDWASD replaced the project's electrical engineer. The new electrical engineer modified a substantial portion of the electrical design. The changes not only affected the electrical portion of work, but also the structural, mechanical, and instrumentation work. These changes were made as the respective work was being performed. P&K coordinated these changes between the design team and its electrical subcontractor, as well as it's others subcontractors, while at the same time maintaining and improving upon the project schedule.

P&K was responsible for scheduling, coordination, procurement, and execution of all aspects of construction of the facilities and process equipment. Due to the high volume of construction work being conducted on the site by other contractors outside of the filter project (14 other construction contracts were under way concurrently), successful completion of the project required extremely close coordination and cooperation with the Owner, Engineer, and other construction contractors. To this end, P&K's contract required multiple phases of construction and twelve distinct Substantial Completion (SC) milestones to maintain smooth operation of the existing treatment facility and coordination with related projects being constructed by others. As of this date, P&K has achieved ten of those twelve milestones ahead of schedule, and is scheduled to complete the remaining SC milestones, as well as Final Completion of the project, ahead of schedule. During construction of the project, the Owner elected to substantially upgrade the control system for the filters from manual controls to a customized web-based, fully automated control system utilizing allowance funds provided within the contract.

P&K's contract also required full-scale performance testing of the filter system to meet the specified performance requirement of less than 5 parts per million total suspended solids (ppm TSS) in the filtered effluent. During testing, the system far exceeded this Contract requirement, consistently producing effluent with TSS of less than 1 ppm.

The City owns a 4.0 million gallon per day (mgd) capacity wastewater treatment plant. Wastewater residuals are beneficially reclaimed by land application to onsite agricultural fields. Treated effluent is discharged to an on-site effluent disposal deep injection well. As part of the City of Punta Gorda's Capital Improvements Program the Wastewater Treatment Plant was scheduled for treatment improvements.

In October 2012, Poole & Kent Company of Florida (P&K) was given the Notice to Proceed on the filtration and disinfection improvements for the City. Improvements included under the project include the following components:

- Demolition of the existing chlorine contact chamber weirs and associated tanks and piping and miscellaneous structures in the location of the new sand filters.

- Construction of a cast-in-place mudwell and mudwell pumping station, including two 7.5 HP submersible pumps.
- Construction of a cast-in-place concrete clear well with a water quality sampling structure.

The City of Belle Glade, part of the Glades Utility Authority (GUA), operates and maintains its wastewater collection and treatment system. The Palm Beach County Water Utilities Department (also part of the GUA) has the authority to implement projects such as this based on its Management and Operations contract with GUA. The wastewater collection and treatment systems have been in urgent need of repair and upgrades. GUA was able to secure \$17 million in grant funding from the United States Economic Development Administration (EDA) to implement the much-needed repairs. This project, consisting mainly of repairs to the headworks, oxidation ditches, and deep injection well disposal system, was funded from those grant proceeds.

In April 2012, Poole & Kent Company of Florida (P&K) was awarded the contract for construction of the following improvements to the existing facility:

- Deep Injection Well system modifications including refurbishment and replacement of several vertical turbine pumps and 300-hp motors (two with variable frequency drives, VFDs) and modifications to piping
- Headworks modifications including new bar screen covers and a wet tap on a 24-inch influent force main
- Demolition of the outdated bulk sodium hypochlorite system/building and construction of new building and equipment consisting of two new fiberglass reinforced plastic dual walled storage tanks, metering pump skids, dilution system, and all associated piping and incidentals
- Modifications to the oxidation ditch splitter box weir and yard piping system feeding the clarifiers
- General site improvements including the addition of a new automatic gate entrance

- Electrical and Instrumentation upgrades including two new VFDs, new programmable logic controller (PLC) panels, PLC programming, new closed circuit television (CCTV) camera system, lighting and all other miscellaneous electrical and instrumentation requirements
- The purchase of waste activated sludge (WAS) and thickened sludge pumps

P&K was responsible scheduling, coordination, procurement, and execution of all aspects of construction of the facilities and equipment. Careful scheduling and planning were required to ensure plant operations were not interrupted while the modifications were being implemented. Work associated with the deep injection well pump system consisted of complete refurbishment of Pump No. 2 and the complete replacement of Pump No. 3. Electrical work consisted of refurbishing the motor on Pump No. 1 and complete replacement of the motor on Pump No. 2. All of the work associated with the injection well system had to be phased so as to maintain adequate disposal capacity of the pumping system during the construction period.



The project was completed under budget and on schedule.



EAST PORT WATER RECLAMATION FACILITY STAGE 1 IMPROVEMENTS PORT CHARLOTTE, FLORIDA





Charlotte County Utilities is a water and wastewater utility serving about 50,000 homes and businesses in Charlotte County. The County's East Port Water Reclamation Facility is a multi-faceted treatment facility that encompasses over 700 acres. In addition to providing wastewater treatment services, the facility houses a state-certified laboratory and waste receiving plant. The water reclamation facility (WRF) is a 6 million gallon per day (mgd) capacity activated sludge wastewater treatment facility that was originally built in 1982. The WRF was upgraded in 1994 to provide reclaimed water to Port Charlotte, and then again in 1996 by the East Port Expansion Phase 1A. Effluent disposal methods currently used include reclaimed water reuse, deep well injection, and slow-rate land application. The site is approximately 80 acres alone and contains two injection wells and two storage reservoirs. The facility also contains a 325 acre irrigation sprayfield.

first stage of expansion. The current project includes the efforts to complete the first stage of the WRF total expansion.

The major treatment process components and improvements for the facility expansion include the following:

- Removal of the three existing Return Activated Sludge (RAS) pumps and the common header and discharge piping. Installation of five new RAS pumps with a new common header and discharge piping.
- Removal of the four existing Internal Recycle (IR) pumps and installation of six new IR pumps.
- Replacement of the drive motors on the four existing mixing aerators in the oxidation ditches with new invertor-duty rated motors with adjustable-speed drives (ASD) and installation of new dissolved oxygen (DO) control system.
- Removal of the existing slide gate in the anoxic tanks and installation of new slide gates.
- Installation of a new baffle plate between the first anoxic tanks and oxidation ditches.
- Construction of a new 2.0 mgd aerobic digester with associated blowers, decanting systems, supernatant return pumps, and feed pumps with associated electrical and controls, including connecting the waste-activated sludge (WAS) and scum pipes from the secondary clarifiers to the new aerobic digester, digested sludge pipes from the new aerobic digester to the belt presses, and supernatant piping from the new aerobic digester to the existing headworks.
- Removal of grit, rags, and other trash in the two oxidation ditches and anoxic tanks, and loading, transport, and disposal. Washing down of tank walls and floor to provide a clean tank.
- Installation of a new truck transfer pumping station with truck-loading pad, trench drain with H-20 traffic grating.
- Rehabilitation of the existing automatic backwash filters No. 1 and No. 2.
- Replacement of one of the bar screens and classifier at the headworks.
- Installation of a new grit transfer pump at the headworks and the replacement of the two existing grit transfer pumps.
- Construction of a belt filter press pump station.
- Construction of two new electrical buildings and related ductbanks, wiring and instrumentation.
- Replacement of a section of the plant 8-in water pipe under the new RAS pump station.
- Replacement of the existing PLC-based SCADA system with a new system, reusing the existing SCADA application and server hardware and expansion of fiber optic communication systems.
- Grading of the stormwater pond and installation of associated improvements.
- Perform piping modifications to the existing North and South Sludge Feed Pumping Stations.

During the bidding phase of the project, all of the bids received by the City exceeded the City's budget for the project. Poole & Kent assisted the City in bringing the project within budget by performing a Value Engineering review of the design and providing recommendations for reducing project costs while accomplishing the project objectives.
