- 4) Term of Contract
 - a) initial one time purchase
 - b) renewals (if any) n/a
 - c) who exercises option to renew n/a
- 5) Contract Amount Total Contract cost is \$268,956.00 (Funding source is Law Enforcement Forfeiture Funds).
- 6) Termination rights With or without cause.
- 7) Indemnity/Insurance Requirements Contractor shall comply with GSA Contract and City purchase order terms and conditions.
- 8) Scope of Services Contractor shall provide the required armored vehicle.
- 9) City's prior experience with Vendor n/a
