Richard Blattner was born in LIma, Ohio and graduated from the University of Wisconsin/Madison with a BS degree. After serving two years active duty with the Army in Korea, he settled in Chicago. While there, he worked for Helen Curtis, Consolidated Distilled Products, and then began a ten year career with Xerox, followed by three years with Saxon Business Products.
