SUBJECT: Proposed First Amendment to the Interlocal Agreement with Broward County for the reuse line extension to West Hollywood.

I have reviewed the above referenced Agreement with the participating Department/Office(s), and the proposed general business terms and other significant provisions are as follows:

- 1) Department/Division involved – Public Utilities
 - 2) Type of Agreement – First Amendment to Interlocal Agreement (Initial ILA approved pursuant to Resolution No. 2016-356)
 - 3) Method of Procurement (RFP, bid, etc.) – n/a
 - 4) Term of Contract:
 - a) initial – 18 months.
 - b) renewals (if any) – yes, for an additional 3 month. **This First Amendment by mutual agreement allows for an extension retroactive from September, 2018 to June 30, 2019.**
 - c) who exercises option to renew – mutual
 - 5) Contract Amount – County will pay City ½ of the cost of the project not to exceed \$132,000.00.
 - 6) Termination Rights – Either party may terminate without cause by giving 30 days' notice.
 - 7) Indemnity/Insurance Requirements – none
 - 8) Scope of Services – City will provide planning, design and permit application services for installation of 17,600 linear feet of a reuse water main along Johnson Street from North Park Road to North 66th Terrace.
 - 9) Other Significant Provisions: none
