- 4) Term of Contract:
 - a) initial 18 months.
 - b) renewals (if any) yes, for an additional 3 month. This First Amendment by mutual agreement allows for an extension retroactive from September, 2018 to June 30, 2019.
 - c) who exercises option to renew mutual
- 5) Contract Amount County will pay City ½ of the cost of the project not to exceed \$132,000.00.
- 6) Termination Rights Either party may terminate without cause by giving 30 days' notice.
- 7) Indemnity/Insurance Requirements none
- 8) Scope of Services City will provide planning, design and permit application services for installation of 17,600 linear feet of a reuse water main along Johnson Street from North Park Road to North 66th Terrace.
