I am a long time Hollywood Hills resident (21 years) and a certified Planner. My professional career as a planner started as a land use planner at the Broward County Planning Department 35 years ago, and then as Assistant City Planner for the City of Sunrise during the Sawgrass Mills development boom (1993-4). I subsequently moved to Atlanta, Ga for 10 years, also completing planning and transportation related projects for Fulton County, Georgia. My career veered to transportation planning while in Georgia and I eventually became a private consultant with several engineering firms. I returned to South Florida 21 years ago and settled in Hollywood Hills. Love Hollywood, really central to regional travel and beautiful!

Currently, I work part-time as a transportation planner for a private engineering firm (CDM Smith). The firm has completed some stormwater planning projects for the City of Hollywood. I am involved on the transportation and land use side of CDM so do not anticipate any potential conflicts.

Below are some highlights of the types of projects I have worked on with local governments in South Florida and the Atlanta area.

As a planner at the end of her professional career, I would like to support the planning and development efforts of the City of Hollywood on a volunteer basis. Thanks for your consideration.

Project Manager. Miami-Dade Department of Transportation and Public Works, Northeast Corridor Rapid Transit Project Development and Environment Study, Miami, Florida, United States. 05/2021-7/2023. Ms. Delgado was the Project Manager for the FTA Project Development process for a proposed commuter rail project along the established FEC corridor. The project included additional stations and train service from Downtown Miami to Aventura, FL. A new starts application process was completed in April 2023 that included conceptual plans, new starts templates and required documents, financial plan, and a documented catex (NEPA). The NEPA document was approved by FTA in November 2023 and the project is programmed to receive \$238 million in federal funds.

Project Manager. Miami-Dade Department of Transportation and Public Works, Beach Corridor Rapid Transit Project Development and Environment Study, Miami, Florida, United States. 05/2017-7/2023. Ms. Delgado supported the Miami-Dade County Department of Transportation and Public Works in conducting the Beach Corridor Rapid Transit project, including preparing a project development and environment study to evaluate light rail transit, bus rapid transit, and other appropriate premium transit technology options between the Miami Design District and the Miami Beach Convention Center. Ms. Delgado coordinated the conceptual engineering, an environmental analysis, cost estimating, and public outreach to evaluate alternatives and make recommendations for one locally preferred alternative. The preferred alternative (\$700 million project) was approved in January 2020, and an Environmental Assessment document was completed with USCG as the lead agency.

Project Manager. Miami-Dade Department Transportation Planning Organization General Planning Consultant, Miami, Florida, United States. 05/2021-7/2023. Ms. Delgado was the Project Manager for the TPO work order based General Planning contract. Through this contract she completed a Mobility Hub planning effort. The study area included the Hard Rock Stadium and entertainment area. Recommended improvements (bike, ped, transit) were proposed to enhance mobility between the entertainment area and a planned park and ride facility at Metrorail proposed end of line.

Project Manager. South Florida Regional Transportation Authority, General Planning Consultant, Pompano Beach, Florida, United States. 05/2020-7/2023. Ms. Delgado was the Project Manager for the SFRTA work order based General Planning contract. Through this contract SFRTA's first Strategic Plan was developed.

Deputy Project Manager, FDOT D4, South Florida East Coast Corridor Study 2005-2008. Odalys was the DPM for a study of the FEC corridor from Palm Beach County to Miami Dade County for implementation of commuter rail. The study involved ridership, engineering, cost estimating, and environmental assessments of impacts to adjacent communities and natural areas. The project was coordinated with the Federal Transit Administration for development of an Environmental Impact Statement. Although ultimately not funded at this time, this project was subsequently divided by segments and now has become the Northeast Corridor in Miami Dade (receiving \$300 million from FTA) and the Broward Commuter rail South project from Aventura to FLL.

Project Manager. City of Miami, FL. 2008-2009- Worked with the City of Miami as a General Planning Consultant to launch a new trolley service city wide. This encompassed route analysis studies, ridership estimates, cost estimating, procurement of vendor support, establishing stops, and wrapping trolleys.

Project Manager, City of Chamblee, GA 2001-2004- Worked with the City of Chamblee as a General Planning Consultant to review and comment on all development and rezoning plans, provide recommendations to the City Commission on development and rezonings, landscape plans etc. Represented the City at the Atlanta MPO. Completed and received federal grants for improvements to the end of the line MARTA station at Chamblee. Assisted in implementation of streetscapes and other improvements with grant funds.

Fulton County Public Works Department, GA, 1994-2000- Worked in the PW Dept developing master bicycle plans, corridor redevelopment plans, traffic signs and signal improvements, intersection improvements, and sidewalk plans. Prepared a grant application for funding of \$400 million in transportation infrastructure improvements. Assisted in implementation of grant dollars for improvements.
