A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, SUPPORTING THE INSTALLATION OF SOLAR POWERED YELLOW SCHOOL ZONE INDICATOR LIGHTS TO “END SCHOOL ZONE” SIGNS BY THE BROWARD COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Broward County has over 1,000 school zone locations with yellow flashing lights; and

WHEREAS, the yellow flashing indicator lights are located on signs which designate the start or beginning of a school zone; and

WHEREAS, the yellow flashing indicator lights are not located on “End School Zone” signs; and

WHEREAS, adding yellow flashing indicator lights to “End School Zone” signs will result in increased visibility of school zones and may result in more vehicles traveling at 15 mph which will result in safer school zones for students and school crossing guards; and

WHEREAS, Miami-Dade County has installed solar power flashing indicator lights to “End School Zone” signs; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Hollywood believes the installation of solar powered yellow school zone indicator lights to “End School Zone” signs are necessary to protect the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City of Hollywood;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That it supports the installation of solar powered yellow school zone indicator lights to “End School Zone” signs by the Broward County School District to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the students of Broward County.

Section 2: That the City Clerk is directed to send a copy of this Resolution to the School Board of Broward County, the Broward County Commission, the Broward League of Cities, and each municipality within Broward County.
