## **Explanation:**

The 2013 Pavement Management Study identified street resurfacing needs in the City of Hollywood. The Engineering and Architectural Services Division of the Department of Public Works prepared specifications and the bid was advertised. Six (6) bids were received and the bid from Weekley Asphalt Paving, Inc. was determined to be the lowest responsive and responsible bidder. Administration recommends awarding a contract with Weekley Asphalt Paving in the amount of \$1,790,891.

On December 3, 2014 the City Commission approved R2014-356 which adopted the FY 2015 Capital Improvement Plan and included funding in the amount of \$500,000 for the Street Resurfacing Program. Funds are available in account number 34.1415.15304.541.006303.

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On December 17, 2014 the City Commission adopted R-2014-375 which amended the adopted CIP and allocated additional funding to the Street Resurfacing project. The following funds are available; Account # 34.1413.13304.541.006303 -\$725,000 and Account # 34.1414.14304.541.006303 -\$750,000.
