
# ECO GRANDE GOLF COURSE CANAL MAINTENANCE PROGRAM

#### Hollywood North Lakes Area Analysis Root Causes of Flooding

- Eco Grande Canal Clogging due to excess vegetation growth and sedimentation fill
- Low land elevation susceptible to flooding (some areas at EL 1 ft-NAVD or lower)
- Runoff flows from higher areas in the west into the neighborhoods
- Groundwater is close to land surface in this neighborhood – low percolation into ground
- Limited and undersized existing collection systems
- 6. Outfalls won't flow at high tides



RED / ORANGE / YELLOW = HIGHER GROUND (EL 10 FT)

GREEN / LT BLUE = LOWER GROUND

DARK BLUE = LOWEST GROUND (EL 1 FT)








Existing Drainage Infrastructure






#### Eco Grande Golf Course Ditch Cleanup

Phase 1	Completed	August 2024
Phase 2	Broward County permit issued-Work in progress	November 2024
Phase 3	<ul> <li>Need Access Agreement with Broward County,</li> <li>Initiate permit application process</li> <li>A Surface Water Management License (SWML) was issued to BCPR</li> <li>COH/DPU will apply SWML Letter of modification once Access Agreement is in place</li> </ul>	December 2024
Phase 4	<ul> <li>Permit application submitted to Broward County</li> <li>Comments received 09/18/2024</li> <li>A Canal Maintenance Easement is recorded in the West Lake Village Plat</li> </ul>	February 2025
Phase 5	<ul> <li>In negotiations with West Lake Village HOA for Canal access</li> <li>A Canal Maintenance Easement is recorded in the West Lake Village Plat</li> <li>COH/DPU is applying for SWML Letter of modification</li> </ul>	June 2025
