A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO APPLY FOR, AND IF AWARDED, ACCEPT FEDERAL FUNDS FROM THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY THROUGH THE HAZARD MITIGATION GRANT PROGRAM FOR A LOCAL HAZARD MITIGATION PROJECT; AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE ALL APPLICABLE GRANT DOCUMENTS AND AGREEMENTS.

WHEREAS, federal aid to supplement state and local hazard mitigation efforts, including the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program ("HMGP"), is available at the state level and is being administered by the Florida Division of Emergency Management; and

WHEREAS, the HMGP provides funding for technically feasible, cost-effective activities that reduce or eliminate long-term risk to people and property from natural hazards and their effects; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Florida Administrative Code 27P-22, Broward County has been designated as one of the Local Mitigation Strategy Working Group participating entities to coordinate mitigation activities within Broward County; and

WHEREAS, Broward County works with local stakeholders to identify, prioritize, and select eligible mitigation activities to be submitted for funding consideration under the HMGP; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Development Services ("DS") provides the highest level of building safety by enforcing the Florida Building Code with the Building Division and further safeguarding the community with the Planning and Urban Design, and Engineering, Transportation and Mobility Services Divisions, to ensure a safe, sustainable, and innovative urban future for residents and businesses; and

WHEREAS, DS desires to add a generator to provide power back-up for the Development Services Hub on the second floor of the Broward County Library-Hollywood location for the protection and functioning of the critical services provided by DS and to allow the Development Service Hub to serve as the City's back up Emergency Operations Center. This project is eligible under the HMGP grant; and

WHEREAS, DS desires to apply for this grant in the approximate amount of \$850,000.00 for a back-up generator project; and

WHEREAS, the HMGP grant requires the City to commit matching funds and a future budget amendment will be required to recognize the grant award and allocate the grant match once notification of award is received.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are incorporated in this Resolution.

Section 2: That it approves and authorizes the appropriate City officials to apply for the HMGP grant in the approximate amount of \$850,000.00 for a back-up generator for the second floor of the library building.

Section 3: That the City Manager is authorized to accept the grant, if awarded, provided that the City Manager shall have the discretion to refuse the grant in those circumstances where he determines it is in the best interest of the City to do so, in which case he shall advise the City Commission of his intention to refuse the grant.

Section 4: That upon the City Manager accepting said award, the appropriate City officials are authorized to execute all agreements and other applicable documents to facilitate acceptance and implementation of the grant, in a form acceptable to the City Manager and approved as to form by the City Attorney.

Section 5: That the Department of Financial Services is authorized to create and establish in the appropriate fund the necessary accounts to recognize the grant funding, if awarded, and to appropriate identified funding for related program expenditures as may be required, including all required matching fund requirements.

Section 6: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
