Explanation:

This Resolution seeks authorization to expend funding from the Law Enforcement Forfeiture Fund (LEFF), to purchase one (1) Police Canine in an amount not to exceed \$14,500.00. The purchase of a Police Canine has not normally been a budgeted expense and was not included as a part of the FY 2015 General Fund budget. This expenditure of Law Enforcement Forfeiture Funds serves a legitimate Law Enforcement purpose as prescribed by Section 932.7055(5)(a) of the Florida Statutes.

Further, this resolution seeks to authorize the Department of Financial Services to recognize revenue and appropriate \$14,500.00 in Net Assets from the Law Enforcement Forfeiture Fund (Fund 12) into an expenditure line item account(s) number, yet to be created by the Department of Financial Services, to provide funding as requested for the purchase of one (1) Police Canine.

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Because Law Enforcement Forfeiture Funds will be used for this purchase, the taxpayers of the City of Hollywood will incur no cost for this expenditure.

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
