

RESOLUTION NO. _____

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY
OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, APPOINTING ONE MEMBER
TO THE AFRICAN AMERICAN ADVISORY COUNCIL.

WHEREAS, the City's African American Advisory Council ("AAAC") was created in 1993 to act as a liaison between the African American community and the City; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. R-93-352 established the African American Advisory Council, Resolution No. R-94-106 established the Board criteria, and Resolution No. R-97-116 increased the membership to 12 members; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. R-2005-293 increased the membership of the AAAC from 12 to 13, and created two alternate positions; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. R-2011-333 increased the number of alternate positions from two to three; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. R-2023-168 eliminated the three alternate positions; and

WHEREAS, the current AAAC consists of 13 members; and

WHEREAS, members must reside or work in the City of Hollywood, be of African American descent, and/or have extensive knowledge and interest in the African American community; and

WHEREAS, there is one vacant unfilled position, whose term expires June 30, 2027; and

WHEREAS, Hollywood resident Christina Frazier has expressed a desire and willingness to fill the member's vacancy.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are incorporated in this Resolution.

Section 2: That following members are appointed to serve on the African American Advisory Council:

1. _____, is appointed as a regular member until June 30, 2027.
