Explanation:

On May 4, 2011, via Resolution R-2011-104, the City Commission approved the negotiation and execution of an agreement between the City of Hollywood and Sunshine After School Child Care, Inc. ("Sunshine") for the operation of an after school and summer camp program at the City's recreation facilities.

The initial term of the agreement was for three (3) years with the option to renew for two (2) additional one (1) year periods. Sunshine has expressed its desire to renew the agreement for the first renewal period (June 22, 2014 through June 21, 2015). The company has provided satisfactory services during the initial period and staff recommends approval of the agreement for an additional one-year period under the same terms and conditions. Sunshine After School Child Care, Inc. shall continue to pay the City 25% of its gross receipts from summer camp programs and 5% of its gross receipts from after school programs.
