A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, RATIFYING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION TO THE BROWARD COUNTY MARINE ADVISORY COMMITTEE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2026-2027 ENHANCED MARINE LAW ENFORCEMENT AND EDUCATION GRANT IN THE APPROXIMATE AMOUNT OF \$151,128.00; AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO ACCEPT THE GRANT, IF AWARDED, AND EXECUTE ALL APPLICABLE GRANT DOCUMENTS.

WHEREAS, the Police Department submitted an application to the Broward County Marine Advisory Committee for the Broward County Enhanced Marine Law Enforcement Grant in the approximate amount of \$151,128.00; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Broward County Enhanced Marine Law Enforcement Grant program is to improve boating safety in Broward County by providing funding to enhance marine law enforcement and education; and

WHEREAS, it is understood that by submitting the grant proposal, the City will comply with the terms and conditions set forth by the Broward County Marine Advisory Committee for the use of grant funds; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police recommends that the City Commission authorize the appropriate City officials to accept, if awarded, the FY 2026-2027 Enhanced Marine Law Enforcement and Education Grant funds from the Broward County Marine Advisory Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are ratified and confirmed as true and correct and are incorporated into this Resolution.

Section 2: That it ratifies the submission of the application for the FY 2026-2027 Enhanced Marine Law Enforcement and Education Grant funds from the Broward County Marine Advisory Committee, in the approximate amount of \$151,128.00.

Section 3: That the City Manager is authorized to accept the grant, if awarded, provided that the City Manager shall have the discretion to refuse the grant if he determines it is in the City's best interest to do so, in which case he shall advise the City Commission of his intention to refuse the grant.
