- 2) Type of Agreement Traffic Control Agreement pursuant to Section 316.006(2)(b), Florida Statutes

- 4) Term of Contract Five years with an option to renew for one (1) additional five year period.
- 5) Contract Amount n/a
- 6) Termination rights Either party may terminate without cause upon 30 days' written notice.
- 7) Indemnity/Insurance Requirements Carriage Hills Condominium, Inc. indemnifies the City of Hollywood.
- 8) Scope of Services The City's Police Dept. will have jurisdiction to enforce state, county and city traffic regulations over any roads within the private community/property of Carriage Hills.
- 9) City's prior experience with Vendor (if any) Yes.
- 10) Other significant provisions In the event that multiparty stop signs should be installed within the property or common areas, Maple Ridge will complete the installation and shall bear the cost for all signage.
