A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE THE ATTACHED RIGHT-OF-WAY OCCUPANCY PERMIT WITH HOLLYWOOD BOULEVARD INVESTMENTS, LLC, FOR THE PLACEMENT OF AN AWNING STRUCTURE PROJECTING OVER THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY AT 1948 HOLLYWOOD BOULEVARD.

WHEREAS, Hollywood Boulevard Investments, LLC, owner of property located at 1948 Hollywood Boulevard, requests approval for the placement of an awning overhang structure across the frontage of the “Jr. B” restaurant, to facilitate shade for its patrons; and

WHEREAS, the awning projection will not encumber into the public right-of-way more than four feet and will maintain a minimum eight foot vertical clearance over the existing walkway within the public rights-of-way for pedestrian activities; and

WHEREAS, in consideration of the request, owners will comply with the terms and conditions specified in the attached right-of-way occupancy Permit, and indemnify and hold harmless the City.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the foregoing “WHEREAS” clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are incorporated in this Resolution.

Section 2: That it approves and authorizes the execution, by the appropriate City officials, of the attached right-of-way occupancy permit with Hollywood Boulevard Investments, LLC, together with such non-material changes as may be acceptable to the City Manager and approved as to form and legal sufficiency by the City Attorney.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
