AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 30 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES ENTITLED "CITY POLICIES, GENERALLY" BY CREATING SECTION 30.06 TO AUTHORIZE AN APPLICATION FEE FOR THE SUBMISSION OF UNSOLICITED PROPOSALS FOR PUBLIC-PRIVATE PARTNERSHIPS IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 287.05712, FLORIDA STATUTES; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Chapter 30 of the Code of Ordinances sets forth general city policies; and

WHEREAS, in 2012, the Florida Legislature passed and adopted House Bill 337 which created Section 287.05712, Florida Statutes to provide for public-private partnerships; and

WHEREAS, as part of the public-private partnership program procurement procedures, Section 287.05712(4)(a) provides that a public entity may establish a reasonable application fee for the submission of an unsolicited proposal; and

WHEREAS, in order to establish such application fee, Section 166.201, Florida Statutes requires that such fees are to be authorized by ordinance;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA:

<u>Section 1</u>: That Section 30.06 of the Code of Ordinances entitled "Application Fee for the Evaluation of Unsolicited Proposals for Public-Private Partnerships" is hereby created as follows:

TITLE III: ADMINISTRATION

CHAPTER 30. CITY POLICIES, GENERALLY

<u>§30.06</u> <u>APPLICATION FEE FOR THE EVALUATION OF UNSOLICITED</u> PROPOSALS FOR PUBLIC-PRIVATE PARTNERSHIPS.

There shall be an application fee for the submission of unsolicited proposals for publicprivate partnerships pursuant to Section 287.05712, Florida Statutes. Such fee shall be established by resolution of the City Commission.

<u>Section 2</u>: That it is the intention of the City Commission and it is hereby ordained that the provisions of this section shall be made a part of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Hollywood, Florida, and the sections of the Code may be renumbered to accomplish such intention.

<u>Section 3</u>: That if any word, phrase, clause, subsection or section of this ordinance is for any reason held unconstitutional or invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect the validity of any remaining portions of this ordinance.

<u>Section 4</u>: That all sections or parts of sections of the Code of Ordinances, all ordinances or parts of ordinances, and all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

<u>Section 5</u>: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
