A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, ESTABLISHING COMPENSATION FOR MEMBERS OF THE CITY COMMISSION.

WHEREAS, over the years, the City Commission approved the guidelines for the implementation of the comprehensive pay plan for non-represented employees, including provisions for salary and benefits for City Commission members; and

WHEREAS, the comprehensive pay plan allows for an adjustment to annual salaries; and

WHEREAS, funding for this matter is available in the FY 2025 Operating Budget and will be budgeted in subsequent fiscal years' operating budgets, subject to approval and adoption by the City Commission.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA.

Section 1: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are incorporated in this Resolution.

Section 2: That the annual base salary of each member of the City Commission, excluding the Mayor, shall be set at \$70,000.00. The annual base salary of the Mayor shall be set at \$100,000.00.

Section 3: That City Commission members who complete at least eight (8) years of service as a member of the City Commission, regardless of whether such years were served consecutively, shall, upon separation from the City, be entitled to continue Individual and Dependent medical coverage at the same cost terms as if they were an active employee as set forth in the current (as of July 2, 2025) Comprehensive Pay Plan, Section 30 (A): Post-Employment Health Insurance Benefits, Senior Executives Health Coverage upon Separation of Employment, as described for Senior Executives hired on or after October 1, 2002 but prior to April 6, 2016. This vested benefit shall apply to all currently serving City Commission members and to all future members of the City Commission. All years of elected service to date shall count toward the eight-year service requirement.

Section 4: That going forward, the City Commission is authorized to receive assignment compensation for serving on various boards and committees as City representatives on behalf of the City.
