

IN RECOGNITION OF DRINKING WATER WEEK

MAY 5-11, 2019

- WHEREAS:** WATER IS OUR MOST VALUABLE NATURAL RESOURCE. WE ARE ALL STEWARDS OF THE WATER INFRASTRUCTURE UPON WHICH FUTURE GENERATIONS DEPEND; AND
- WHEREAS:** ANY MEASURE OF A SUCCESSFUL SOCIETY – LOW MORTALITY RATES, ECONOMIC GROWTH AND DIVERSITY, PRODUCTIVITY, AS WELL AS PUBLIC SAFETY ARE ALL IN SOME WAY RELATED TO HAVING ACCESS TO SAFE DRINKING WATER. ONLY TAP WATER DELIVERS PUBLIC HEALTH PROTECTION AND FIRE PROTECTION, AS WELL AS SUPPORTS OUR ECONOMY AND THE QUALITY OF LIFE WE ENJOY; AND
- WHEREAS:** THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD’S WATER TREATMENT PLANT PRODUCES AN AVERAGE OF 22 MILLION GALLONS OF WATER PER DAY. EACH RESIDENT OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD IS CALLED UPON TO HELP PROTECT OUR SOURCE WATERS FROM POLLUTION, PRACTICE WATER CONSERVATION, AND GET INVOLVED IN LOCAL WATER ISSUES; AND
- WHEREAS:** THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC UTILITIES HAS AGAIN PARTICIPATED IN THE ANNUAL “DROP SAVERS WATER CONSERVATION POSTER CONTEST”, AND ESTABLISHED THE “DROP SAVERS AT THE ARTSPARK AT YOUNG CIRCLE GALLERY SHOW”; AND
- WHEREAS:** THE CITY’S PUBLIC UTILITIES EMPLOYEES AND THE AMERICAN WATER WORKS ASSOCIATION ARE BEING RECOGNIZED FOR THEIR DEDICATION TO PROVIDING SAFE, CLEAN DRINKING WATER FOR OVER ONE HUNDRED YEARS; NOW
