This project will improve access to jobs by connecting residents to major employment centers such as Memorial Hospital while supporting local businesses. It will close transit gaps by linking east and west Hollywood with Tri-Rail, BCT and community shuttles, improving system efficiency and first/last mile access across key corridors.				

Please be advised that the funding award cited above requires local funds from the City of Hollywood to match the State funds programmed for this project. Therefore, please provide certification of available funds for the project no later than January 1, 2026. Funding is subject to the availability of an annual appropriation by the Florida Legislature. Prior to commencement of any work or services, the City of Hollywood must enter into a Public Transit Grant Agreement (PTGA) with FDOT.
