- WHEREAS,** AUGUST 14, 2025, MARKS THE 90TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE SOCIAL SECURITY ACT, SIGNED INTO LAW IN 1935, ESTABLISHING ONE OF THE MOST ENDURING INSTITUTIONS IN AMERICAN HISTORY; AND
- WHEREAS,** FOR NINE DECADES, SOCIAL SECURITY HAS TRANSFORMED THE LIVES OF MILLIONS OF AMERICANS BY PROVIDING CRUCIAL ECONOMIC SECURITY TO RETIREES, INDIVIDUALS WITH DISABILITIES, SURVIVORS, AND THEIR FAMILIES; AND
- WHEREAS** SOCIAL SECURITY HAS SERVED AS THE FOUNDATION OF ECONOMIC SECURITY FOR GENERATIONS OF AMERICANS, HELPING INDIVIDUALS ENJOY A BETTER QUALITY OF LIFE IN RETIREMENT WITH DIGNITY, INDEPENDENCE, AND PEACE OF MIND; AND
- WHEREAS,** SOCIAL SECURITY CONTRIBUTES SIGNIFICANTLY TO THE COUNTRY'S ECONOMY, GENERATING NEARLY \$1.6 TRILLION, ANNUALLY IN ECONOMIC ACTIVITY; THE PROGRAM HAS HELPED TO REDUCE POVERTY AMONG OLDER AMERICANS AND VULNERABLE POPULATIONS, ENABLING THEM TO LIVE WITH DIGNITY AND INDEPENDENCE; AND
- WHEREAS,** SOCIAL SECURITY, EARNED THROUGH A LIFETIME OF HARD WORK AND PAYROLL CONTRIBUTIONS, REMAINS A TRUSTED COMMITMENT TO WORKERS OF ALL INCOME LEVELS, BACKGROUNDS, AND POLITICAL BELIEFS. IT CONTINUES TO MAINTAIN THE TRUST AND CONFIDENCE OF THE AMERICAN PEOPLE BY PROVIDING CRUCIAL SUPPORT THEY RELY ON TO SECURE ESSENTIAL NEEDS LIKE HOUSING, FOOD, AND HEALTH CARE, SAFEGUARDING THEIR FUTURE WELL-BEING.; AND
- WHEREAS,** AS WE COMMEMORATE THIS MILESTONE, IT IS FITTING TO RECOGNIZE THE IMPORTANCE OF PROTECTING AND STRENGTHENING SOCIAL SECURITY FOR CURRENT AND FUTURE GENERATIONS; NOW
