Dear Mr. Skaggs:

The City of Hollywood is in receipt of your letter dated January 6, 2023, which was in response to the City's letter dated December 21, 2022. In your letter, you stated that Waste Pro USA held discussions with former Department of Public Works staff regarding adjustments in operations and investments in equipment, staff, etc., in lieu of fines, which is not stipulated in the City's contract with Waste Pro USA. You also stated that Waste Pro USA has issues with alleyway collection despite the contract requiring the collection of garbage, recyclables, and bulk waste in alleyways.

As discussed during the meeting between City staff and representatives of Waste Pro USA on December 22, 2022, it is Waste Pro USA's responsibility to appear before the Hollywood City Commission if it desires to propose modifications to the contract. City staff will schedule a meeting with the City Commission for Waste Pro USA representatives to present their concerns.
