



In the mid-1920s, at the peak of Hollywood's boom, thousands flocked to the beach to promenade on the Broadwalk, dance at the Tangerine Tea Room (above, building at left), swim, and even go on wheels. The 1925 photograph shows dressed-up passengers

relaxing in cabs resembling buggies with a driver who pedaled from behind (center). Today several small shops have replaced the tea room at the corner of Johnson Street and the Broadwalk (looking north), and the group bikes are now self-propelled.
