A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE A BLANKET PURCHASE AGREEMENT WITH BROWARD SHERIFF'S OFFICE FOR THE PURCHASE OF MEDICAL SUPPLIES, FIRE EQUIPMENT AND JANITORIAL SUPPLIES IN AN ANNUAL AMOUNT UP TO \$170,000.00, IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 38.41(C)(9) OF THE PROCUREMENT CODE. (BEST INTEREST)

WHEREAS, the provision of emergency services by the Fire Rescue and Beach Safety Department ("Department") requires the purchase and maintenance of medical supplies, fire equipment and janitorial supplies vital to its operation in accordance with the Department's State of Florida Emergency Medical License; and

WHEREAS, the Broward County Sheriff's Office ("BSO") has established a program to allow governmental entities to purchase medical supplies, fire equipment and janitorial supplies directly from the Sheriff at their cost without markups or handling fees; and

WHEREAS, BSO is located within Broward County, FL and easily accessible by the Department for any of the required goods; and

WHEREAS, the Department continues to experience supply chain issues for such goods and the Blanket Purchase Agreement will create another avenue to purchase these items quickly on an "as-needed" basis; and

WHEREAS, BSO utilizes the same Florida Regional EMS protocols as the City's emergency service units and supplies are delivered within 24 hours; and

WHEREAS, the medical supplies, fire equipment and janitorial supplies are provided "as is" with all faults and BSO makes no representations or warranties regarding the fire and medical supplies; and

WHEREAS, BSO has been supplying the Department with medical supplies, fire equipment, and janitorial supplies since at least 2016 and the Department desires to continue to participate in such a program; and

WHEREAS, Section 38.41(C)(9) of the Procurement Code states that when the City Commission declares by a five-sevenths (5/7ths) affirmative vote that competitive bidding and competitive proposals are not in the best interest of the City, such purchases are exempt from competitive bidding and competitive proposal requirements; and

WHEREAS, the Department wishes to participate in the program for an additional one-year period, during which the desired medical supplies, fire equipment and janitorial supplies, will be acquired from October 19, 2025, through October 18, 2026; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Chief recommends that the City Commission approve and authorize the issuance of the attached Blanket Purchase Agreement with BSO for medical supplies, fire equipment and janitorial supplies in an annual amount up to \$170,000.00; and

WHEREAS, funding for the Blanket Purchase Agreement will be available in the FY 2026 Operating Budget in account numbers 001.215101.52200.552320.000000.000, 001.215101.52200.546310.000000.000, and 001.215101.52200.552310.000000.000, subject to approval and adoption by the City Commission.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA:

<u>Section 1</u>: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are incorporated in this Resolution.

<u>Section 2</u>: That it approves and authorizes the execution, by the appropriate City officials, of the attached Blanket Purchase Agreement with BSO, together with such non-material changes as may be subsequently agreed to by the City Manager and approved as to form and legal sufficiency by the City Attorney.

<u>Section 3</u>: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
