A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, RANKING FIRMS TO PROVIDE DESIGN-BUILD SERVICES FOR TWO PICKLEBALL COURTS; AUTHORIZING APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO NEGOTIATE AN AGREEMENT WITH THE HIGHEST RANKED FIRM, MERRICK INDUSTRIAL MANAGEMENT CORPORATION, FOR CONSIDERATION AND APPROVAL BY THE CITY COMMISSION AT A LATER DATE.

WHEREAS, the Department of Parks, Recreation and Cultural Arts desires to enter into an agreement with Merrick Industrial Management Corporation to provide design-build services for two pickleball courts at Stanley Goldman Memorial Park; and

WHEREAS, the services were procured pursuant to Section 287.055, Florida Statutes, known as the Consultants' Competitive Negotiation Act; and

WHEREAS, on November 23, 2022, Request for Qualifications Number RFQ-022-23-GJ ("RFQ") was electronically advertised on OpenGov.com to solicit qualified firms to provide design-build services for two pickleball courts in accordance with Section 38.43(A) of the Procurement Code; and

WHEREAS, the RFQ resulted in submittals from the following two firms by the response due date:

- 1. Merrick Industrial Management Corporation
- 2. Sports Surfaces; and

WHEREAS, on March 16, 2023, the Selection Committee met to evaluate and rank the submittals based upon the following Evaluation Criteria established in the RFQ: Firm Qualifications and Experience; Organization Profile and Design-Build Team Qualifications; Approach to Scope of Work – Design and Technical Approach; Past Performance and References; and

WHEREAS, based on the Evaluation Criteria, the Selection Committee evaluated the two proposals, and the scores were compiled to arrive at the following rankings:

1. Merrick Industrial Management Corporation

Ranked #1

2. Sports Surfaces

Ranked #2; and

WHEREAS, the Selection Committee recommends that the City Commission authorize the appropriate City officials to negotiate an agreement with the highest ranked

firm, Merrick Industrial Management Corporation, to design and build two pickleball courts at Stanley Goldman Memorial Park; and

WHEREAS, funding for the agreement was included in the amended FY 2023 Plan, Capital Improvement and is available in number account 301.309902.57200.563060.001540.000.000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA.

That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are ratified and confirmed Section 1: as being true and correct and are incorporated in this Resolution.

That it ranks the firms as follows: Section 2:

1. Merrick Industrial Management Corporation

2. Sports Surfaces

Ranked #1

Ranked #2

That it authorizes the appropriate City officials to enter into Section 3: negotiations with the highest ranked firm, and if unable to come to an agreement with that firm, to terminate negotiations with that firm and commence negotiations with the next highest ranked firm, in order, until an agreement is reached.

Section 4: That upon the appropriate City officials successfully negotiating an agreement, the negotiated agreement will be brought back to the City Commission for consideration and approval.

That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon Section 5: its passage and adoption.
