A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, APPOINTING ELEVEN MEMBERS TO THE AFFORDABLE HOUSING ADVISORY COMMITTEE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 420.9076, Florida Statutes, the City is required to create an Affordable Housing Advisory Committee; and

WHEREAS, Section 160.06 of the City Code of Ordinances established the City's Affordable Housing Advisory Committee ("Committee") to comply with state law; and

WHEREAS, the Committee shall recommend specific actions or initiatives to encourage or facilitate affordable housing while protecting the ability of the property to appreciate in value; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 420.9076, Florida Statutes, the Committee shall consist of at least eight but not more than 11 members and must consist of one representative from at least six of the categories set forth below:

- 1. One citizen who is actively engaged in the residential home building industry in connection with affordable housing;
- 2. One citizen who is actively engaged in the banking or mortgage banking industry in connection with affordable housing;
- 3. One citizen who is a representative of those areas of labor actively engaged in home building in connection with affordable housing;
- 4. One citizen who is actively engaged as an advocate for low-income persons in connection with affordable housing;
- One citizen who is actively engaged as a for-profit provider of affordable housing;
- 6. One citizen who is actively engaged as a not-for-profit provider of affordable housing;
- 7. One citizen who is actively engaged as a real estate professional in connection with affordable housing;

- 8. One citizen who actively serves on the City's local planning agency pursuant to Section 163.3174, Florida Statutes;
- 9. One citizen who resides within the City of Hollywood, Florida;
- 10. One citizen who represents employers within the jurisdiction of the City of Hollywood; and
- 11. One citizen who represents essential services personnel, as defined in the local housing assistance plan; and

WHEREAS, currently eight member seat terms expire on June 30, 2019, and there are three vacant positions that also expire on June 30, 2019 as set forth below:

- 1. Nancy Gaggino residential home building industry.
- 2. A vacant position due to the resignation of Roary Carlson banking or mortgage banking industry.
- 3. A vacant never filled position labor actively engaged in home building.
- 4. David Kout advocate for low-income persons.
- 5. Mohammad Reza Ronizi for-profit provider of affordable housing.
- 6. Henry Graham not-for-profit provider of affordable housing.
- 7. Sara Levenka real estate professional.
- 8. David McLeod actively serves on the City's local planning agency.
- 9. Travis Bridges resides within the City of Hollywood.
- 10. A vacant never filled position citizen who represents employers.
