Explanation:

The 2007/2008 Wastewater Master Plan included the need to rehabilitate and upgrade several existing sanitary sewer lift stations. This project is currently addressing two lift stations; A-10 located at 6951 Fillmore St and A-11 located at 7415 McKinley St.

The Department of Public Utilities requested a proposal from AECOM to provide professional engineering services for the design, bid and construction services for the Lift Station Conversation/Upgrade Project for Lift Stations A-10 and A-11.

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Administration recommends issuing an Authorization to Proceed with AECOM for a lump sum of \$102,750.

On November 7, 2012, the City Commission adopted R-2012-358 that amending multiple years of Capital Improvement Plan included FY 2011 and added additional funding to the Lift Station Conversion project. Funds are available in account # 42.4000.86871.536.013121.

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
