- WHEREAS,** ON APRIL 22, 1970, MILLIONS OF AMERICANS CAME TOGETHER TO CELEBRATE THE FIRST EARTH DAY; AND
- WHEREAS,** STUDENTS, TEACHERS, ACTIVISTS, ELECTED OFFICIALS, AND COUNTLESS OTHERS CHALLENGED OUR NATION TO CONFRONT OUR MOST URGENT ENVIRONMENTAL ISSUES AND RALLIED AROUND A SINGLE MESSAGE: THE SUCCESS OF FUTURE GENERATIONS DEPENDS ON HOW WE ACT TODAY; AND

- WHEREAS,** WE RECOMMIT TO THE SPIRIT OF TOGETHERNESS AND SHARED RESPONSIBILITY THAT GALVANIZED A MOVEMENT 50 YEARS AGO; AND
- WHEREAS,** THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD ENCOURAGES AND SUPPORTS A HEALTHY ENVIRONMENT THROUGH VARIOUS PRACTICES, EVENTS AND REGULATIONS; AND
