SUBJECT: Proposed Agreement with Broward County to Amend Interlocal Agreement for Development of Saltwater Intrusion Model

I have reviewed the above-captioned agreement for form and legality, and the general business terms and other significant provisions are as follows:

- 1) Department/Office involved – Public Utilities
- 2) Type of Agreement – 1st Amendment to Interlocal Agreement
- 3) Method of Procurement (RFP, bid, etc.) – n/a
- 4) Term of Contract
 - a) initial – The amendment extends the term from 48 mths. to 57 mths.
 - b) renewals (if any) –
 - c) who exercises option to renew –
- 5) Contract Amount - \$41,666.67 (no change)
- 6) Termination rights – Either party can terminate without cause by giving 30 days' notice (no change).
- 7) Indemnity/Insurance Requirements – None (no change)
- 8) Scope of Services – County is developing a saltwater intrusion model for south Broward (no change).
- 9) City's prior experience with Vendor – Yes.
- 10) Other significant provisions – None.
