

AGREEMENT
FOR LIMITED FOOD SERVICES AT CITY HALL

This AGREEMENT made and entered into this 6 day of January, 2016, by and between CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, a municipal corporation of the State of Florida, herein after referred to as "City", and GINO ITALIAN AMERICAN DELI & MEAT MARKET, INC., a Florida corporation, herein referred to as the "Contractor" whose principal address is 5729 Johnson Street, Hollywood, FL 33021.

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the City of Hollywood sought the services of a qualified and experienced food service provider to provide limited food services at the food emporium, located on the second floor of City Hall, at 2600 Hollywood Boulevard, Hollywood, FL 33020 and on July 24, 2012, issued RLI Number 4330-12-RD seeking said services; and

WHEREAS, on August 10, 2012, RLI Number 4330-12-RD was opened and resulted in 8 (eight) responses; and

WHEREAS, on August 27, 2012 the City Manager authorized the appropriate City Officials to enter into agreements with the top 5 (five) food service providers for limited food services operations at City Hall on a rotating basis; and

WHEREAS, Gino Italian American Deli and Meat Market was chosen to provide the food services; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hollywood and Contractor desire to enter into this Agreement for Food Services at City Hall, under the terms and conditions contained herein,

NOW, THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL CONVENANTS EXPRESSED HEREIN, THE PARTIES HERETO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

ARTICLE 1
NON EXCLUSIVITY

Nothing herein is intended nor shall be construed as creating any exclusive Agreement with the Contractor. The Contractor shall not restrict the City from acquiring, similar, equal or like goods and services from other entities or sources.

ARTICLE 2
INCORPORATION OF DOCUMENTS

The RLI, Number 4330-12-RD issued on July 24, 2012, including any addenda thereto, the response submitted by the Contractor are incorporated herein by reference in their entirety (the RLI Documents). The RLI shall be attached hereto as "Exhibit A" and the proposal submitted by the Contractor shall be additionally attached hereto as "Exhibit B". Except as otherwise provided in this Agreement, the parties shall comply with the terms and conditions set forth in the RLI Documents.

**ARTICLE 3
DAYS AND HOURS OF OPERATION**

The initial hours of operation shall be from 10:00 a.m. to 2:30 p.m., Monday through Thursday, City holidays exempted. The final days and hours of operation shall be mutually agreed upon by both parties, in writing.

Additionally, the Contractor will be permitted (but not required) to close for the week that occurs between Christmas Day and New Year's Eve.

**ARTICLE 4
OBLIGATIONS OF THE PARTIES**

A. The City shall:

- 1) Provide turnkey facilities of approximately 522 square feet located on the second floor of City Hall for the operation of the food emporium.
- 2) Maintain the building and building systems equipment at the City's expense. However, this shall not include any equipment that is the property of the Contractor or its duly authorized representatives.
- 3) Provide, without charge, all utilities required for operation of the food emporium. However, the City does not guarantee uninterrupted supply of any utility nor shall it be responsible for any expenses or losses which may result, directly or indirectly, from an interruption or malfunction of any utility. The City shall be diligent in its efforts to restore any utility should an interruption or malfunction occur.
- 4) Provide and maintain without charge the following kitchen equipment:
 - 1 each – 30-gal. water heater
 - 1 each – hand sink
 - 1 each – three compartment sink
 - 1 each – drain for soda machine under counter
 - 1 each – floor drain in rear of food emporium
 - 1 each – 150 amp panel 3 phase 120/208 volts
 - 30 each – circuit capability
 - 1 each – L-shape counter
 - 1 each – utility station 60" x 28"
 - 1 each – utility station 46" x 28"
 - 1 each – ice dispenser, Scotsman with wall unit icemaker
 - 2 each – working tables, stainless steel 74" x 28"
 - 1 each – fire extinguisher
 - 1 each – refrigerator, reach-in Arctic Air
 - 1 each – table (tv-type)
 - 1 each - double door refrigerator (True Manf) model GDM49 (display)
 - 1 each - single door refrigerator (True Manf) model GDM23 (display)

(All electric in food emporium is 120 volts).

B. The Contractor shall:

- 1) Be responsible for reasonable protection and care in the use of the assigned space and in the use City's equipment.
- 2) Ensure adequate service is provided for City employees and visitors during scheduled hours.
- 3) Sell only food and beverages that comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws. Pursuant to City policy, the sale of alcoholic beverages shall not be permitted.
- 4) Be certified and licensed for the types of services specified and proposed. The Contractor shall obtain all necessary licenses, certifications, and permits at their sole expense and furnish copies of same to the City of Hollywood upon notice of award.
- 5) Be responsible for complying with all provisions applicable to the Occupational Safety and Health Act as enforced by the U.S. Department of Labor and to require all employees to comply with this law and all regulatory state or local laws affecting job safety.
- 6) Operate the food emporium in a safe manner that is complementary to a well-kept public building, and be responsible for sanitation, cleanliness, and general housekeeping.
- 7) Provide any equipment necessary to the operations of the food emporium with the exception of equipment to be provided by the City as described in the City's obligations section. The title for all equipment provided by the Contractor shall remain with Contractor.
- 8) Deposit at the end of each operating day all trash, garbage and recycled materials in dumpsters and designated receptacles provided without charge by the City.
- 9) Provide for a daily cleaning procedure, which shall be implemented at the end of each operating day to prevent the unsafe accumulation of grease and food residue.
- 10) Comply with all ordinances, regulations and directives issued by any public health agency and any other regulatory or enforcement agencies having jurisdiction over the operation.
- 11) Allow access to the area at all times by the City's Director of Procurement Services, or his/her designee for inspection. Contractor shall correct all deficiencies identified in writing by the City.

12) be permitted to bring the following equipment to the food emporium, and shall be solely responsible for all maintenance, repairs, damages, theft, etc., refrigerator, steam table, cold cut slicer, flat top and toasters.

13) Advertise the food emporium in the Library and throughout City Hall.

ARTICLE 5 CONTRACTOR EMPLOYEES

The Contractor shall be responsible for hiring personnel to adequately operate the food emporium. All hiring shall conform to all requirements of the Federal, State and local laws relating to minimum wages, background checks, Social Security, Civil Right Act of 1964, unemployment compensation, workers' compensation and Health Department. Employees shall observe all applicable rules and regulations.

The Contractor must ensure that each employee exhibits cleanliness and good personal hygiene and takes adequate measures to ensure that food is not contaminated.

The Contractor must ensure that no employee smokes in any area where food is prepared, dispensed or stored.

The Contractor must ensure that each employee washes his or her hands as often as necessary to prevent the contamination of food. The Contractor shall additionally provide hand sanitizers available to employees.

The Contractor is responsible for every employee hired. Copies of the employee's background check information shall be provided to the City at no charge, prior to start of work in the food emporium. The City reserves the right to conduct an extensive background check on any employee of the Contractor at its sole cost and expense. If unfavorable information is found, the City reserves the right to request termination of the employee immediately.

ARTICLE 6 MODIFICATIONS

The food emporium may be upgraded or remodeled at the Contractor's expense upon written approval of the appropriate City officials. Any changes must comply with the City's Building Code Regulations and must be accessible in accordance with F.S. 553.503, Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA).

ARTICLE 7 MENU

Contractor shall provide a limited menu of made to order or pre-made healthy lite-meals including, without limitation, salads, sandwiches, fresh soups, beverages and premium coffee services twice weekly for up to fifty individuals suitable to the food emporium operation.

Coffee shall be made fresh daily and must be available throughout the day.

Contractor agrees that no cooking or similar activity which creates an odor shall be permitted in the food emporium.

**ARTICLE 8
TAXES**

The Contractor will be responsible for payment of all sales tax due and also pay any and all taxes required directly to the Federal, State and local authorities.

**ARTICLE 9
TERM**

The term of this Agreement shall be for a one (1) year period from January 6, 2016 through January 5, 2017 and may be renewed for ten (10) additional one (1) year terms upon mutual agreement of the parties.

**ARTICLE 10
TERMINATION**

The City reserves the right to terminate this agreement immediately with or without cause upon written notice to the Contractor. Such notice will not be required to state the reason(s) for termination.

**ARTICLE 11
LICENSING**

Contractor, during the entire term of this Agreement, must maintain all appropriate State, County and local licensing.

**ARTICLE 12
ASSIGNMENT**

Contractor shall not assign this Agreement, or transfer ownership or assign or transfer any services or work to be provided to the City without the prior written consent of the City. The City reserves the right to accept or reject the transfer or assignment of this Agreement in its sole and absolute discretion.

**ARTICLE 13
INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS**

Contractor shall maintain, at its sole expense, during the term of this Agreement the following insurances:

Prior to the commencement of work governed by this contract, the Contractor shall obtain General Liability Insurance. Coverage shall be maintained throughout the life of the contract and include, as a minimum:

- Premises Operations
- Products and Completed Operations
- Blanket Contractual Liability
- Personal Injury Liability
- Expanded Definition of Property Damage

The minimum limits acceptable shall be:

\$300,000 Combined Single Limit (CSL)

If split limits are provided, the minimum limits acceptable shall be:

- \$100,000 per Person
- \$300,000 per Occurrence
- \$ 50,000 Property Damage

An Occurrence Form policy is preferred. If coverage is provided on a Claims Made policy, its provisions should include coverage for claims filed on or after the effective date of this Agreement. In addition, the period for which claims may be reported should extend for a minimum of twelve (12) months following the acceptance of work by the City.

The City of Hollywood shall be named as Additional Insured on all policies issued to satisfy the above requirements.

Recognizing that the work governed by this Agreement requires the use of vehicles, the Contractor, prior to the commencement of work, shall obtain Vehicle Liability Insurance.

Coverage shall be maintained throughout the life of the Agreement and include, as a minimum, liability coverage for:

- Owned, Non-Owned, and Hired Vehicles

The minimum limits acceptable shall be:

\$100,000 Combined Single Limit (CSL)

If split limits are provided, the minimum limits acceptable shall be:

- \$ 50,000 per Person
- \$100,000 per Occurrence
- \$ 25,000 Property Damage

The City of Hollywood shall be named as Additional Insured on all policies issued to satisfy the above requirements.

Worker's Compensation Insurance covering the Contractor and the Contractor's employees with not less than the following limits:

Worker's Compensation \$100,000/500,000/100,000 for coverage

Please Note: The Certificate shall contain a provision that coverage afforded under the policy will not be cancelled until at least thirty (30) days prior written notice has been given to the City. In the event the Certificate of Insurance provided indicates that the insurance shall terminate and lapse during the period of this Agreement, the vendor shall furnish, at least thirty (30) days prior to the expiration of the date of such insurance, a renewed Certificate of Insurance as proof that equal and like coverage for the balance of the period of the Agreement or extension thereunder is in effect.

The insurance policy shall not contain any exceptions that would exclude coverage for risks that can be directly or reasonably related to the scope of goods or services in this bid/proposal. A violation of this requirement at any time during the term, or any extension thereof shall be grounds for the immediate termination of any Agreement

entered in to pursuant to this bid/proposal. In order to show that this requirement has been met, along with an insurance declaration sheet demonstrating the existence of a valid policy of insurance meeting the requirements of this bid/proposal, the successful proposer must submit a signed statement from insurance agency of record that the full policy contains no such exception.

The City reserves the right to require additional insurance in order to meet the full value of the Agreement.

The City reserves the right to require any other insurance coverage it deems necessary depending upon the exposures.

**ARTICLE 14
EQUAL EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY**

Contractor shall provide a written statement that it does not and will not discriminate against any person, employee, or applicant for employment, because of race, creed, color, religion, sex, national origin, ancestry, age or disability.

**ARTICLE 15
HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNIFICATION**

The Contractor shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless the City of Hollywood, its elected and appointed officials, employees and agents for any and all suits, actions, legal or administrative proceedings, claims, damage, liabilities, interest, attorney's fees, costs of any kind whether arising prior to the start of activities or following the completion or acceptance and in any manner directly or indirectly caused, occasioned or contributed to in whole or in part by reason of any act, error or omission, fault or negligence whether active or passive by the Contractor, or anyone acting under its direction, control, or on its behalf in connection with or incident to its performance of the Agreement.

**ARTICLE 16
NOTICE**

REQUEST FOR LETTERS OF INTEREST TO PROVIDE LIMITED FOOD SERVICES AT CITY HALL, 2600 HOLLYWOOD BOULEVARD, HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, TWICE WEEKLY FOR A TRIAL PERIOD.

The City of Hollywood hereby notifies all interested parties of its desire to seek professional, qualified and experienced food service providers to sell, at a reasonable price, a limited menu of made to order or pre-made healthy lite-meals including salads, sandwiches, fresh soups, beverages and premium coffees services twice weekly on the second floor of City Hall for up to 50 individuals daily.

At this stage, the City is primarily interested to enter into an agreement with a select number of interested professional, qualified and experienced food service providers to participate on a rotating basis during a trial period of up to four months in order to determine the viability for both parties. This is viewed as an amenity to City employees and visitors, their satisfaction is an important consideration in any evaluation process.

Upon the agreed schedule the City will provide at no charge, a 525 +/- square foot room with a hand sink, three compartment sink, under counter drain for soda machine, a floor drain in rear of snack shop, an L-shape counter, a utility station 60" x 28", a utility station 46" x 28", a Scotsman Model CM3 unit icemaker and ice dispenser, a commercial reach-in Arctic Air refrigerator, a Magic Chef residential type, 17 cu ft double door refrigerator, a True model GDM49 double door refrigerated display case and a True model GDM23 single door refrigerated display case.

A walk-thru site visit of the room is scheduled for Friday, August 3, 2012 at 2 pm to 2:30 pm and Tuesday, August 7, 2012 at 10 am to 10:30 am. The walk-thru site visit is optional and not mandatory.

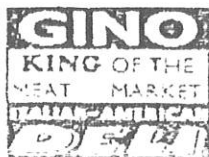



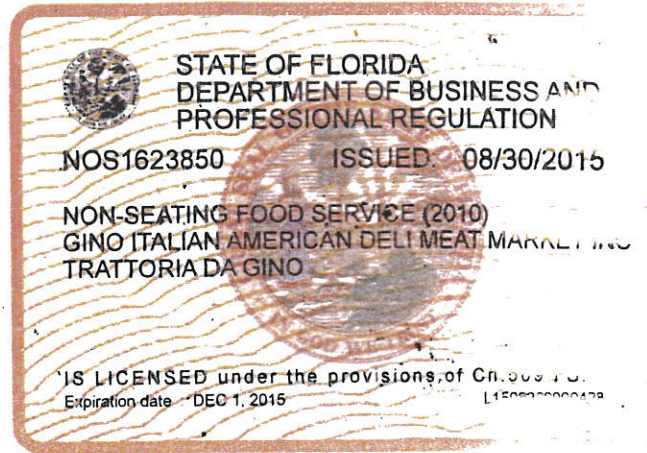
