A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE THE ATTACHED MEMORANDUM UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE CITY AND THE COUNTY POLICE BROWARD BENEVOLENT ASSOCIATION ("PBA") AMENDING THE TERMS OF THE COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY AND THE PBA TO ALLOW THE POLICE CHIEF FLEXIBILITY WITH RESPECT TO THE PAY OF REHIRED FORMER POLICE OFFICERS AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE RESTORATION OF SENIORITY UPON REHIRE.

WHEREAS, the City and the PBA are parties to a collective bargaining agreement ("CBA") from the period of October 1, 2014 through September 30, 2017 covering the police officers, police sergeants and police lieutenants of the City; and

WHEREAS, Section 31.6 of the CBA addresses the seniority, pay and probationary period of former police officers who have a permanent break in service and are re-hired; and

WHEREAS, the parties wish to amend Section 31.6 of the CBA and other sections, as necessary, to allow the Police Chief flexibility with respect to the pay of rehired former police officers and provide for the restoration of seniority upon re-hire based on the re-hired employees' previous years of service with the City;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA:

<u>Section 1</u>: That it hereby approves and authorizes the execution, by the appropriate City Officials, of the attached Memorandum of Understanding between the City of Hollywood and the Broward County Police Benevolent Association, in substantially the form attached hereto, together with such nonmaterial changes, if any, as may be subsequently agreed to by the City Manager and approved as to form and legality by the City Attorney.
