A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY
OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, APPOINTING A VICE MAYOR
FOR A ONE-YEAR TERM.

WHEREAS, Section 2.03 of the City Charter states that the City Commission shall, by a majority vote of the total Commission membership eligible to vote and on an annual basis, select a Vice Mayor; and

WHEREAS, the Charter provides that the Vice Mayor shall serve for a term of one year; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. R-2020-172 provides that the City Commission intends, as a general rule, to elect the Commissioner who has continuously held the office of Commissioner the longest without having served as the Vice Mayor; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. R-2023-036 provides that the City Commission intends, in the event there is a tie amongst the Commissioners with the continuously held office of Commissioner the longest without having served as the Vice Mayor, the Commissioner from the District whose Commissioner has not served as Vice Mayor the longest shall be appointed; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. R-2024-408 appointed Idelma Quintana as Vice Mayor to serve a term of one-year, effective December 4, 2024; and

WHEREAS, a new Vice Mayor must be appointed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the forgoing "WHEREAS" clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are incorporated in this Resolution.

Section 2: That _____ is appointed to serve as Vice Mayor for a one-year term, effective December 10, 2025.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
