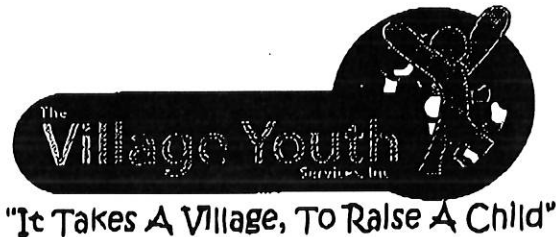

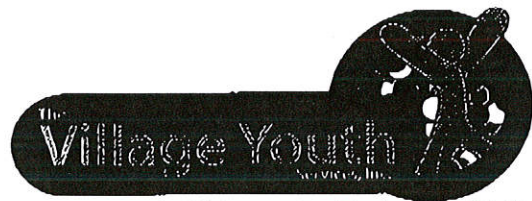
Proposal for City of Hollywood Summer 2015 and Aftercare 2015-16 Food Service

The Village Youth Services, Inc. (TVYS) is a non-profit, 501c3 organization dedicated to improving the lives of South Florida youth by providing nutritious meals to students in order to help them excel in school and grow up happy and healthy. We have been providing free lunches and snacks for afterschool programs, summer camps, and community programs throughout Dade, Broward, and Palm Beach Counties for over 8 years and are committed to continuing to provide South Florida youth with healthy, nutritious meals.

Founded in 2005, the agency's initial goal was to provide afterschool tutoring services to youth in the fields of reading and math. However, while providing these services, many of the participants would complain of being hungry and unable to focus. Ultimately through the Child Care Food Program offered by the USDA we were able to begin providing nutritious meals to the youth in our communities.

Since 2007, The Village Youth Services has become known state-wide for offering free meals during both the summer and school year to numerous agencies in Dade, Broward, and Palm Beach Counties. In 2012, TVYS was selected as the sole provider of afterschool meals and snacks for The Children's Trust grant-funded programs. Through this grant, our agency is responsible for the administration of both summer and afterschool meals and snacks for over 130 Trust-funded sites. Additionally, through our innovative approach to snack administration for Trust-funded sites, our agency also offers free nutrition education workshops to both parents and children to educate them on the importance of healthy eating and staying active and fit. It is our intention to extend these free nutrition education workshops to the City of Hollywood's participants, parents, and staff if awarded this opportunity.

Our belief is that it truly takes a village to raise a child, and it is all of our duty to ensure our youth grow up both healthy and strong.



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PURPOSE

The purpose of the Summer Food Service Program (SFSP) and Afterschool Meal Program (AMP) is to provide healthy meals year-round to children under the age of 18.

The SFSP is subsidized by the U.S. Department of Agriculture, and regulated by the Florida Department of Agriculture. While the AMP is funded by the U.S. Department of Agriculture and regulated by the Department of Health.

The Village Youth Services will provide the meals to the City of Hollywood's Park, Recreation and Cultural Arts Department's four summer camps and one aftercare site. Additionally, our agency will provide nutrition education classes to participants, staff, and parents.

TIMEFRAME

The time frame for implementation would be as follows:

- SFSP
 - June 8, 2015 through August 21, 2015.
- AMP
 - August 24, 2015 through June 10, 2016.

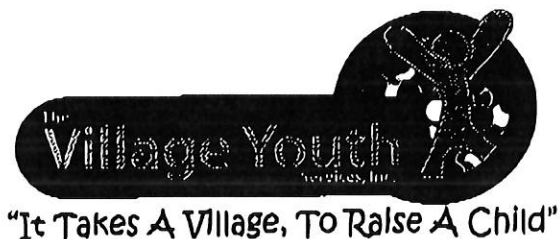
If chosen, we are open to extending our partnership beyond the original terms.

MEALS

All meals provided meet the USDA's guidelines, and are procured by our state-approved vendor, Greater Miami Caterers, having over 30 years' experience in the food service industry. Under SFSP only two meal types can be selected.

* Available only during Teacher's Planning Day, Winter Break, and Spring Break.



COST

Meals are available at no cost to either program or participants 18 years of age or younger.

TRAINING

In order to receive the meal service, program staff are required to attend training. At least two representatives from each site will have to attend one training session before meals can be delivered to the site; however, it is highly recommended that all staff are properly trained on all aspects of the program. Trainings are required in order to administrate the food program properly and safely.

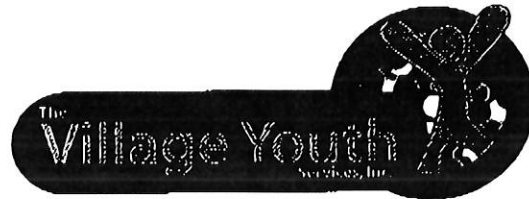

EQUIPMENT

Each site is responsible for informing sponsor about equipment needs prior to the start of the program. Refrigerators and/or food warmers are available to sites if needed.

FIELDTRIPS

Field trip dates and times are to be submitted to the sponsor at the beginning of summer or afterschool service. Any changes should be emailed 48 hours in advance to allow time for processing. Sites that go on fieldtrips will receive cold lunches, if lunches must be transported to the field trip site.



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DELIVERY

For any issues with delivery, please contact the sponsor first and follow-up with an email.

- ***Late Delivery***
Discuss the problem with the driver and make a note of the problem on the delivery receipt. If the problem continues, call your sponsor.
- ***No Delivery***
If your meals have not arrived within 1 hour of your scheduled meal service, please call our office immediately. Our staff will immediately contact the vendor to obtain ETA or make alternate arrangements for meal service.

PROGRAM CONCERNS

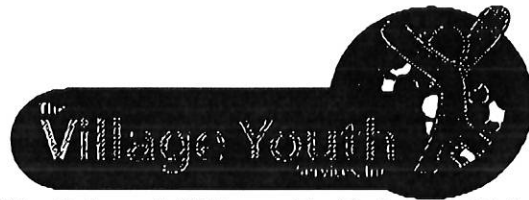
- Step 1. If there is an issue, site staff should contact their assigned program assistant.
- Step 2. If the problem is not resolved by the program assistant, contact program coordinator.
- Step 3. The site staff may contact the Executive Director if no resolution is provided.

However, please note site staff may contact the Executive Director at any time if needed.

SITE INFORMATION

During the summer, TVYS serves between 150-180 sites. For summer 2014, we provided meals for over 170 summer camps, bible schools, recreation centers, and youth organizations, serving more than 10,000 lunches daily.

Currently, we are responsible for ensuring that over 75 Trust-funded sites in Dade County receive afterschool snacks and suppers.
