A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, APPOINTING NINE MEMBERS TO THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT ADVISORY BOARD.

WHEREAS, the City Commission passed and adopted Resolution No. R-2015-168, establishing the Community Development Advisory Board ("CDAB"), consisting of 11 board members whose primary responsibility is to make recommendations to the City Commission on matters involving Community Development Block Grant ("CDBG") funds, HOME funds, and other federal funds that may be allocated; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. R-2015-168, CDAB members must be qualified electors in the City and priority shall be given to representatives from geographical areas of the City designated as qualified by the United States Census Bureau as having greater than 51% concentrations of low/moderate income ("LMI") persons; and

WHEREAS, the CDAB holds several public hearings each year in accordance with the requirements of the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development; and

WHEREAS, Milana Walter, whose term expires June 30, 2025; and Hector Mujica, whose term expires June 30, 2026, have resigned from the Board; and

WHEREAS, Mitch Anton, Krista Berry, Philipe de Souza, and Shoshana Hill's terms expire on June 30, 2025; and

WHEREAS, Mary Mites Campbell, who serves as the primary alternate member and whose term expires on June 30, 2027 has resigned from the CDAB; and

WHEREAS, John Strader currently serves as the secondary alternate member and is being submitted for consideration for reappointment to the CDAB as a regular voting member based on eligibility and continued interest in serving; and

WHEREAS, if John Strader is reappointed as a regular voting member, the secondary alternate position shall become vacant, and the City Commission will appoint one of the remaining qualified applicants to serve in that role; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission recognizes the value of enhanced collaboration and informed decision-making through the inclusion of individuals who hold positions of public trust and leadership; and

WHEREAS, there is a desire to create an ex-officio member position on the CDAB to ensure that the perspective and expertise of federal, state or local officials, department heads, or agency representatives is consistently represented; and

WHEREAS, State Representative Marie Woodson currently serves as a regular member of the CDAB and is being submitted for consideration for reappointment as an ex-officio voting member, based on her eligibility and continued interest in serving; and

WHEREAS, if State Representative Marie Woodson is reappointed as ex-officio voting member, her current regular member position will become available, and the City Commission will appoint one of the remaining qualified applicants to fill that role;

WHEREAS, the City Clerk provided notice to the public that positions were available and solicited interest forms from citizens to fill available vacancies; and

WHEREAS, the following individuals have expressed a desire and willingness to fill the member vacancies:
