A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY
OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, ESTABLISHING VARIOUS
WATER FEES, CHARGES AND DEPOSITS FOR WATER
SERVICES.

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Hollywood, Florida adopted Ordinance No. O-2014-15 which amends Chapter 51 of the Code of Ordinances, titled "WATER," removing various fees, charges, and deposits and allowing for them to be established by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Hollywood, Florida, via this Resolution, wishes to establish the water and sewer fees, charges and deposits related to Chapter 51 "WATER" of the Code of Ordinances;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That pursuant to Section §51.030 (C), the cancellation charge shall be \$25.00.

Section 2: That pursuant to Section §51.030 (D), the application fee shall be \$20.00.

Section 3: That pursuant to Section §51.032 (B), the reconnection fee shall be \$25.00.

Section 4: That pursuant to Section §51.034 (A), the required deposit shall be as follows:

Residential - Single-family, Duplex, Triplex \$50.00 per unit.

Residential - Multi-family 4 Units and More/Hotels and Motels \$40.00 per unit

Non-Residential:

Delinquent accounts: In addition to the required deposit shall be assessed an additional \$50.00 deposit.

Section 5: That pursuant to Section §51.035 (B), the non-refundable application fee shall be \$100.00, and the temporary water service deposit shall be \$1,500.00.

Section 6: That pursuant to Section §51.035 (E) (1), the monthly minimum charge shall be \$15.00.

Section 7: That pursuant to Section §51.041(C), the water hydrant annual maintenance charge shall be \$65.00.

Section 8: That pursuant to Section §51.041 (D), the water hydrant annual rental charge shall be \$65.00.

Section 9: That pursuant to Section §51.060 (A), there shall be a monthly availability charge as follows: for fire line sizes of four inches or less, \$15.00, and for fire line sizes larger than four inches, \$30.00.

Section 10: That pursuant to Section §51.071 (A), the field visit fee shall be \$15.00.

Section 11: That pursuant to Section §51.073 (B), the service charge shall be \$25.00.

Section 12: That pursuant to Section §51.074 (B), for meter sizes of 1 inch or less the meter test service fee shall be \$50.00, and for meter sizes larger than 1 inch the meter test service fee shall be \$100.00.

Section 13: That pursuant to Section §51.074 (C), for meters that are three inches or more in size, the meter test service fee shall be \$150.00. A charge of \$12.50 per month shall appear on the customer's bill to pay the cost of the test.

Additional tests within the same annual period shall be \$150.00.

Section 14: That pursuant to Section §51.130 (B), the turn-off charge shall be \$25.00.

Section 15: That pursuant to Section §51.130 (C), the disconnection fee shall \$35.00, and the administrative fee shall be \$50.00.

Section 16: That pursuant to Section §51.130 (D), the administrative fee shall be \$50.00.

Section 17: That pursuant to Section §51.130 (E) (1), the disconnection fee shall be \$35.00, and the administrative fee shall be \$50.00.

Section 18: That pursuant to Section §51.130 (E) (2), the disconnection fee shall be \$35.00, the administrative fee shall be \$50.00, the disabling water flow service fee shall be \$300.00, and the restoring service fee shall be \$300.00.

Section 19: That pursuant to Section §51.130 (G), the service charge shall be \$300.00.

Section 20: That pursuant to Section 51.142 (B) (1), the service disconnection fee per occurrence shall be \$35.00, the non-after-hours service reconnection fee per occurrence shall be \$25.00, and the after-hours reconnection fee per occurrence shall be \$50.00.

After hour service includes those cases where both the customer request is received and the reconnection service is performed before 8:30 a.m. or after 4:00 p.m. Monday through Friday, or any time on weekends and holidays.

Section 21: That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
