The Naming Review Committee of the City of Hollywood, Florida, (the “Committee”) was called to order on Wednesday, November 10, 2021 at 10:08 AM, as a virtual meeting.

Patricia A. Cerny, City Clerk, thanked everyone for attending the meeting.

Patricia A. Cerny, City Clerk, stated that the meeting was publicly noticed in accordance with Florida Statutes.

Patricia A. Cerny, City Clerk, explained the Committee was reconvened as the petition supporting the naming proposal and other additional information requested by the Commission at the last meeting, October 13, 2021, was received from Chloe Chin to name the skatepark at Stanley Goldman Memorial Park for Justice Michael Kiziah Chin. The skatepark will be called “Justice Skatepark”.

ACTION: Motion was made by Raelin Storey, Director of Communication, Marketing & Economic Development, and seconded by Alison Saffold, Civic Affairs Administrator, to recommend to the City Commission the naming of the skatepark at Stanley Goldman Memorial Park be named Justice Skatepark. The motion passed unanimously.

ACTION: Motion was made by Raelin Storey, Director of Communication, Marketing & Economic Development, and seconded by Ricky Engle, Director of Parks, Recreation and Cultural Arts, to approve the Committee minutes of October 13, 2021. The motion pass unanimously.

The naming of the skatepark will go before the City Commission in January or February, 2022.
