A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE A BLANKET PURCHASE AGREEMENT WITH DEBRISTECH, LLC TO PROVIDE EMERGENCY DEBRIS MONITORING SERVICES FOR A VARIETY OF DISASTER RELATED INCIDENTS FOR A TWO-YEAR TERM IN AN ANNUAL AMOUNT UP TO \$3,000,000.00.

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works (“Department”) desires to enter into an Emergency Debris Monitoring Services Agreement so the City is in compliance with all federal, state and local regulations, to ensure the protection of public health and safety, and to ensure environmental protections are being implemented and adhere to; and

WHEREAS, these services will monitor a variety of disaster related services including, but not limited to, clearing and removal of large-scale debris, separation, staging and disposal, as well as demolition work and removal; and

WHEREAS, on February 18, 2025, Request for Proposals No. RFP-287-25-AR (“RFP”) was electronically advertised on OpenGov.com to solicit the desired Debris Monitoring Services in accordance with Section 38.43(A) of the Procurement Code; and

WHEREAS, on March 18, 2025, the RFP was closed and resulted in proposals from the following five firms:

1.	DebrisTech, LLC
2.	Thompson Consulting Services, LLC
3.	Disaster Program & Operations, Inc.
4.	Insight Planning and Development
5.	Tetra Tech, Inc.

; and

WHEREAS, on April 9, 2025, the Selection Committee comprised of in-house professionals met to evaluate and rank the proposals based upon the approved Evaluation Criteria established in the RFP: Firm Qualifications and Experience; Resources and Availability, Quality of Services, Operational Plan, Price, and Past Performance; and

WHEREAS, based on the Evaluation Criteria, the Selection Committee evaluated the five proposals, and the scores were compiled to arrive at the following rankings, with the highest score being the highest ranked:

1.	DebrisTech, LLC	94.75 Points
2.	Thompson Consulting Services, LLC	83.50 Points
3.	Disaster Program & Operations, Inc.	70.25 Points
4.	Insight Planning and Development	64.50 Points
5.	Tetra Tech, Inc.	63.50 Points

; and

WHEREAS, the City and the Department will work directly with FEMA and any other agencies to recover funding in the event of a disaster; and

WHEREAS, the Director of the Department and Director of Procurement and Contract Compliance recommend that the City Commission authorize the execution of a Blanket Purchase Agreement with the highest ranked firm, DebrisTech, LLC, for a term of two years with an option to renew for two additional one-year periods to provide Emergency Debris Monitoring Services; and

WHEREAS, funding for these services will be provided from the Emergency/Disaster Fund 168, with accounts to be established as needed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA.

Section 1: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are incorporated in this Resolution.

Section 2: That the City Commission approves the ranking of the firms as follows:

1. DebrisTech, LLC
2. Thompson Consulting Services, LLC
3. Disaster Program & Operations Inc.
4. Insight Planning and Development
5. Tetra Tech, Inc.

Section 3: That it approves and authorizes the execution, by the appropriate City officials, of a Blanket Purchase Agreement with DebrisTech, LLC, together with such non-material changes as may be subsequently agreed in a form acceptable to the City Manager and approved as to form by the City Attorney.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
