Dear Mr. Joinville:

This letter report provides an analysis of the Department of Public Utilities (Department) review of the bids received for the 2023 Drainage Improvements and a recommendation for award of contract.

The bid proposal and supporting information were evaluated for bidder responsiveness and the Contractors' overall technical ability to perform the work proposed by the Department's Contract Documents. The evaluation consisted of the following:

- 1) The Department prepared a side-by side tabulation of the bids received, checked for math errors and anomalies in Unit Prices. The bidders for the project in order of overall lowest bid are:

Southeastern Engineering Contractors, Inc.	\$4,766,814.90	1
Man-Con, Inc.	\$6,260,342.00	2
The Stout Group, LLC.	\$6,744,915.00	3
David Mancini and Sons, Inc.	\$8,981,905.00	4

Based on our review and evaluation of the Bid Proposals, the Department recommends that the project be awarded to the **three lowest responsive and responsible** bidders, **Southeastern Engineering Contractors, Inc., Man-Con, Inc. and The Stout Group, LLC.**, in amounts not to exceed \$1,200,000.00, \$1,000,000.00, and \$800,000.00 respectively for the 2023 Drainage Infrastructure Improvements. Please note that bid totals reflect sample bid items and quantities for bid evaluation purposes, and that not all bid items are anticipated to be utilized for the project.
