A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE TERMINATION OF THE PHASE I PRECONSTRUCTION SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH LEGO CONSTRUCTION CO. FOR THE ART AND CULTURE CENTER/HOLLYWOOD.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. R-2019-025, the City Commission authorized the appropriate City officials to negotiate and execute a Continuing Services Agreement with the three highest ranked firms to provide construction management at risk services for capital improvement projects, one of the firms being Lego Construction Co. ("Lego"); and

WHEREAS, on March 1, 2021, the City and Lego executed a continuing services agreement ("Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, Article 8, Section 8.4 of the Agreement provides that the City may terminate the Agreement for convenience; and

WHEREAS, the Director of the Department of Design and Construction Management recommends that the Agreement be terminated for convenience; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 38.49 of the Procurement Code, when a contract is entered into by the City Commission and is terminable by the City without cause, only the City Commission is authorized to terminate the contract without cause.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA:

<u>Section 1</u>: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are incorporated in this Resolution.

Section 2: That it terminates the Agreement with Lego Construction Co.

<u>Section 3</u>: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
