### **Priority Funding:**

- 1. \$200,000 Boulevard Heights ADA Ramp and Sidewalk Access
- 2. \$400,000 Police Headquarters Radio Tower
- 3. Fred Lippman Center Funding

## **Coordinated Funding:**

- 1. Beach Renourishment and Sand-By-Pass Funding
- 2. Sadowski Affordable Housing Trust Fund advocate for full funding of trust fund dollars
- 3. Visit Florida Funding (Visit Florida was reauthorized until October 1, 2023)

- 3. Continue to serve as the City's liaison to the Executive Office of the Governor and other relevant state agencies, such as the: Florida Department of Economic Opportunity (DEO), Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), Florida Division of Emergency Management (DEM), Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission (FWC), Florida Housing Finance Corporation (FHFC)
