A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO ISSUE A BLANKET PURCHASE AGREEMENT TO GARBER CHEVROLET BUICK GMC FOR THE PURCHASE OF 48 2022 CHEVROLET TAHOE 1500 RWD VEHICLES IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,901,904.00, BASED UPON THE FLORIDA SHERIFF ASSOCIATION AGREEMENT BID NO. FSA20-VEL28.0 AND IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 38.41(C)(5) OF THE CITY'S PROCUREMENT CODE (PIGGYBACK).

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works, Fleet Management Division, on behalf of the Police Department, requires the purchase of 48 new vehicles to replace a portion of the existing Police Patrol and K9 vehicles that have reached or surpassed their life expectancy and road worthiness by age, mileage, and/or wear, and as a result are no longer dependable to support operational needs; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department is requesting 48 2022 Chevrolet Tahoe 1500 RWD vehicles, Specification #CC10706/9C1/PPV, to be purchased off the Florida Association Bid Number FSA20-VEL 28.0, which is valid through September 30, 2022; and

WHEREAS, Garber Chevrolet Buick GMC has agreed to provide to the City the exact pricing and the same terms and conditions for 48 2022 Chevrolet Tahoe 1500 RWD vehicles, Specification #CC10706/9C1/PPV, as outlined in the Florida Sheriff Association Bid Number FSA20-VEL28.0; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department believes that the Tahoe 1500 RWD (PPV) model was evaluated and is determined to be the best fit for the City Police Patrol and K9 Division's operational needs and services; and

WHEREAS, Section 38.41(C)(5) of the City's Procurement Code allows the Chief Procurement Officer to procure, without formal solicitation procedures, all goods, supplies, materials, equipment, and services that are the subject of contracts with the State, its political subdivisions, the United States government, other governmental entities, or a corporation not for profit whose members are governmental entities, public officers, or any combination thereof ("piggyback"), provided that the goods, supplies, materials, equipment, or services are the subject of a price schedule negotiated by the entities listed above and is based strictly on competitive bids, quotations, or competitive proposals and not on any preference and such utilization of other governmental entities contracts shall be permitted only during the term of the other governmental entity's contract; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Works and the Chief Procurement Officer recommend that the City Commission approve and authorize the issuance of the attached Blanket Purchase Agreement to Garber Chevrolet Buick GMC for 48 new vehicles for the Police Department, in the total amount of \$1,901,904.00; and

WHEREAS, funding for the Blanket Purchase Agreement was included in the Fiscal Year 2022 Capital Improvement Plan, and is available in account number 335.519902.51900.564520.001381.000.000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are incorporated in this Resolution.

Section 2: That it approves and authorizes the issuance, by the appropriate City officials, of the Blanket Purchase Agreement to Garber Chevrolet Buick GMC, together with such non-material changes as may be subsequently agreed to by the City Manager and approved as to form and legal sufficiency by the City Attorney.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
